NOTICE TO SHOW CAUSE

WHEREAS, a letter No. F. No. 24/MISC/NH/DHS/2012/PF-I/121 dated 02.08.2018 was issued by this Directorate directing therein to submit a copy of valid Fire Safety Clearance Certificate from Delhi Fire Services within one month of receipt of this letter failing which appropriate action would be initiated against your nursing home/hospital as per the provisions laid down under Delhi Nursing Homes Registration Act, 1953 and Rules framed thereunder from time to time.

WHEREAS, another letter No. F. No. 24/MISC/NH/DHS/2012/PF-I/1735 dated 14.02.2019 was issued by this Directorate mentioning therein to submit a copy of valid Fire Safety Clearance Certificate from Delhi Fire Services within one month of receipt of this letter failing which appropriate action would be initiated against your nursing home/hospital as per the provisions laid down under Delhi Nursing Homes Registration Act, 1953 and Rules framed thereunder from time to time.

WHEREAS, a letter No. F.6/DFS/MS/2019/Misc/1150 dated 11.03.2019 was received from Chief Fire Officer, Directorate of Delhi Fire Service, GNCTD mentioning therein that hospitals and nursing homes fall under the category of Institutional Buildings, which having height more than 9 meters or having ground plus two upper stories including mezzanine floors, are covered under sub Rule 5 of Rule 27. The fire prevention and fire safety provisions as mentioned under Rule 33 of the said Rules shall be as per the provisions contained in Building Bye Laws and National Building Code of India part 4.

WHEREAS, in the aforementioned letter received from Chief Fire Officer, Delhi Fire Service further mentioned that the Fire and life safety requirement varies according to the year of construction/ conversion of occupancy and accordingly, each individual case alongwith sanctioned building plans including section/ elevation of the premises having details of the area, abutting road, year of construction/ conversion of occupancy, width of exits duly marked with

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stipulated fire and life safety provisions as per NBC are required to be forwarded by the concerned local authority or license issuing agency before issue of license for necessary scrutiny.

THEREFORE, in exercise of powers conferred under section 7 read with section 8(i) of Delhi Nursing Home Registration Act, 1953, I, Dr. Ashok Kumar, Director General, Health Services and Supervising Authority for registration of Nursing Homes/Hospitals, hereby issue a notice to show cause within one calendar month from the date of receipt of this notice, as to why an order of cancellation of registration in r/o

should not be issued since there is violation of sub Section (d) of Section 5 of Delhi Nursing Homes Registration Act, 1953.
