Note 1: The departmental officer in the feeder Grade who are in the direct line of promotion will not be This Department, since 2013 is not having a regular Chief Engineer and the post of Chief Engineer has been managed under CDC charge. The primary reasons for not having Chief Engineer on regular basis are that:-

feeder Grade who are in the direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

Note 2: Period of deputation (ISTC) including period of deputation (ISTC) in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed 5 years.
