As you are aware, 26th November is celebrated every year as Constitution Day to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India and to honour and acknowledge the contributions of the Founding Fathers of the Constitution of India. The current year marks the 70<sup>th</sup> year of adoption of the Constitution and it has been decided by the Government to run an awareness campaign focused on Citizens' duties including Fundamental Duties as enshrined in the Constitution, from 26th November, 2019 and subsequent activities culminating in celebration of Dr. Ambedkar Jayanti on 14<sup>th</sup> April, 2020.

As part of the Nation-wide celebration of the Constitution Day, specific activities are required to be taken up at State, District, Urban Local Bodies and Panchayat level in your State/UT. The activities may be spread throughout the period from 26<sup>th</sup> November, 2019 upto 14<sup>th</sup> April, 2020 and may include following:

i. Reading of the Preamble in all offices and bodies of the Constitution at 11.00 AM on 26<sup>th</sup> November, 2019

ii. Organization of talks/conferences/seminars/rallies/walks/runs focused on citizens' duties. The list of resource persons for delivering talks/lectures would soon be available on the website of Department of Justice at https://doj.gov.in

iii. Public readings of report cards/success stories/good practices of various flagship schemes of the Ministry of Women and Child Development

iv. Identifying one or more citizens' duties like observing swachhata, discarding single use plastic, etc., and making an action plan to inspire people to voluntarily participate in these duties

v. Publicity and awareness campaign through flyers, banners, standees with active participation of WCD/Social Welfare Departments of States/UTs at all level.
