

CIRCULAR

In order to streamline the procedure and to prevent any misuse of retention policy of Transport Department, henceforth, the following procedure should be adopted for retention of registration marks in respect of vehicles reported stolen by vehicle owners:-

- a. A FIR should have been registered for the stolen vehicle.
- b. The untraced report will have to be produced alongwith application for retention of existing registration mark.
- c. The stolen vehicle should have a valid insurance as on date of FIR.
- d. Application for retention of registration mark of a stolen vehicle can be made within 180 days only from the date of untraced report.
- e. The owner shall submit an undertaking that the matter of claim of the said stolen vehicle with insurance company and court case, arises if any, after retention of registration mark of stolen vehicle, will be settled by the registered owner at his/her own level.

This issues with the prior approval of Secretary-cum-Commissioner (Transport).
