CIRCULAR

The annual observance of International Day of Persons with Disabilities (IDPD) is on 3 December. The observance of the Day aims to promote an understanding of disability issues and mobilize support for the dignity, rights and well-being of persons with disabilities. It also seeks to increase awareness of gains to be derived from the integration of persons with disabilities in every aspect of political, social, economic and cultural life. The theme for the IDPD 2020 is "Building Back Better: toward a disability-inclusive, accessible and sustainable post COVID-19 World".

In this regard, by considering the current COVID-19 pandemic situation, all HOS of the Govt., Govt. Aided, MCD, NDMC, DCB & MCD Aided, and NDMC Aided Schools are directed to conduct following competitions through online mode among Children with Special Needs (CWSN):

Instructions:


1. The theme for the IDPD 2020 is "Building Back Better: towards a disability-inclusive, accessible and sustainable post COVID-19 World". It focuses on recovering from pandemic and creating a disability-inclusive and sustainable society where persons with disabilities can enjoy equal access.
2. Competitions shall be held separately for each level for each item.
3. All the entries of above mentioned four items shall be prepared by the CWSN at home on 3rd December 2020 during 08.00 AM to 02.00 PM. Parents/guardians shall ensure that entries are prepared by the CWSN himself/herself and they shall only provide necessary guidance.
4. TGT (Special Education Teacher)/Resource Persons (CWSN)/Special Educators in case of MCD Schools/Teacher in-charges shall provide necessary support to CWSN online.
5. Drawing sheets(A-4/A-3) shall be provided to CWSN who wish to participate in drawing and/or slogan writing, if needed, by HOS latest by 02.12.2020.



6. Videos of Singing/Poem Recitation and Solo Dance by CWSN shall be made at home. Videos shall be of maximum two minutes duration and the same shall be recorded in school uniform.
7. Such prepared entries shall be submitted by the parents to concerned TGT (Special Education Teacher)/Resource Person (CWSN)/Special Educator in case of MCD Schools/Teacher in-charge in the school latest by 05.12.2020
8. HOS shall constitute a committee of TGT (SET)/Resource Person (CWSN)/Special Educator in case of MCD Schools/Teacher in-charge, Drawing Teacher, and Music Teacher at school level and evaluate the entries submitted by CWSN latest by 12.12.2020.
9. One best entry from each item and each level along with the Name of student, Student ID, Class & Section, School Name & ID, Type of Disability, and Percentage of Disability shall be submitted to concerned District Coordinator (IE), DoE latest by 15.12.2020 for further consideration in respect of district & state level program. Along with the entries schools shall also submit a report with regard to the organization of these competitions.
10. HOS shall ensure that all CWSN enrolled in the school shall participate at least in one competition.

In addition to above, **HOS shall ensure that all subject teachers who are taking online classes for children with or without disabilities conduct five minutes discussion about the significance of the IDPD.**
