
Subject: Celebration of National Voters' Day on 25th January, 2021.

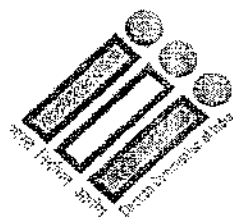
