Dear Chief Secretary

There are instances when the MSMEs face difficulties in realizing their payments for the goods and services supplied by them. Government Departments/Organizations/PSUs also procure goods and services from MSMEs. It is imperative that the Government should release the payments to MSMEs on time. It was in this context that we had written on two occasions (11th June, 2020, & 04th August, 2020) requesting your intervention in monitoring delay in payment with the concerned Departments/Organizations/PSUs under the control of the State Government. It may kindly be recalled that this was also one of the announcements made by the Central Government as part of Atma Nirbhar Bharat package. Further, as per the provisions of MSME Development Act, 2006, MSE dues have to be released within 45 days.

- 2. My Ministry has been receiving several representations from MSEs as well as the MSME Associations regarding delays in payment from State Government Departments/PSUs etc and also regarding delays in disposal of cases pending with the MSEFCs. Details of cases which have been filed by MSMEs, State-wise, are available online at our portal http://samadhaan.msme.gov.in.
- 3. I shall be grateful if you could direct the MSEFC and concerned departments/PSUs in your State for immediate resolution of such pending cases. Regular meetings of MSEFC can go a long way in resolving the issues of MSE payments.
