Note 2: The crucial date for determining the age-limit shall be as advertised by the UPSC/ Competent Authority.
7.	Educational and other Qualification required for Direct Recruits	Essential: 1. Masters Degree in Punjabi with English or Hindi as an elective subject at Degree level from a recognized University or equivalent.
