

Dear Madam/Sir(s),

The Information and Communication Technology (ICT) component under Samagra Shiksha has provisions for creating of ICT infrastructure in schools and Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) to facilitate innovative use of ICT in school and teacher education leading to improvement in quality in all the spheres of school and teacher education. National Education Policy (NEP) – 2020 recommend on the extensive use of technology in teaching and learning, removing language barriers, increasing access for Divyang students teacher preparation (at Pre-service and in-service teacher education level) and educational planning and management. It further lays emphasis upon motivating teacher by recognizing and promoting outstanding works of teacher and incentivizing teacher to do their best work.

To motivate teachers, teacher educators, and States/UTs, apart from the teacher award, two new award categories have been introduced as part of National ICT Award for use of ICT in education. Now there will be three (03) award categories, one for School Teachers, second for Teacher Educators and third for Best Practicing States/UTs to encourage wide use of ICT in their respective fields. In all, 36 awards are instituted by Govt of India for School Teachers, 10 awards for Teacher Educators and 3 awards for Best Practicing States/UTs. **Online self-nominations by School teachers and Teacher Educators are open till 30th June 2022 and online self-nominations for Best Practicing States/ UTs are open till 31st July, 2022. Stakeholders can access the online portal by clicking on (<https://ictaward.ncert.gov.in/>).**

The award proposes to felicitate those Teachers, Teacher Educators and States/UTs who have enhanced student learning by effectively and innovatively integrating technology supported learning into the school curriculum and subject teaching, and thereby promoted enquiry-based cooperative-collaborative learning using ICT among their students. Teachers of foundational, Preparatory, Middle, Secondary schools pertaining to the following organizations are eligible to be nominated under the scheme:

- i. State Government Schools, Schools run by local bodies, Government Aided Schools and Schools affiliated to State Boards of Education
- ii. Central Government schools i.e. Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs), Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas (JNVs), Schools run by Ministry of Defence (MOD) i.e. Sainik Schools, Eklayva Model Residential Schools under Ministry of Tribal Affairs and schools run by Atomic Energy Education Society (AEES) etc.
- iii. Schools affiliated to Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) other than those at (i) and (ii) above.
- iv. Schools affiliated to Council for Indian Schools Certificate Examinations (CISCE)
- v. Teacher Educators of BIETs, DIETs, CTEs, IASEs, SIEMAT, SCERTs, SIEs, SIETs and Colleges, Universities run by Centre / State Govt / UT administration and Private Universities (from 2021 onwards).
- vi. SPDs of Samagra Shiksha / School Education Secretaries of States / UTs for best practices by respective States / UTs (from 2021 onwards) in the area of School Education.

The last date to submit the entries for Best Practicing State/ UT's through ICT Award portal is 31st July, 2022.

The last date for forwarding of short listed candidates by State Govt./UTs/Autonomous Organizations to the Joint Director, CIET-NCERT, New Delhi-110016 is 31st July, 2022. For more details about ICT Award you can visit: <https://ictaward.ncert.gov.in/>. A copy of newspaper advertisement (in

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES/ NOMINATIONS

As per the guidelines of the scheme, the selection process for identifying the awardee involves the following:

1. Nominees need to register themselves on the portal **www.ictaward.ncert.gov.in** by providing mobile number or email id, and choosing a password. After registration they can login and apply online by answering different questions on the portal. The portal has the option to upload your work in Google Drive or PDF and video. It's a self-nomination award. Any teacher can apply directly by filling the application form online through the web portal before the prescribed cutoff date. Teachers need to send detailed entries in the prescribed format along with supporting documents to the Directorate of Education of their respective States/UTs/ Autonomous Organizations through proper channel (Principal/DEO/Regional Offices, etc).
2. For States/UTs after self-nomination the State level committee headed by Secretary (School Education/ SPD- Samagra Shiksha, Director, SCERT/SIE, two experts in the field of ICT nominated by Secretary (School Education) will scrutinize all the entries and shortlist the candidates and forward the shortlisted entries to the Joint Director, Central Institute of Educational Technology (CIET), NCERT, New Delhi-110016 for future action.
3. For autonomous bodies Committee under the chairpersonship of Secretary/ Commissioner (Education)/ Chairman of the concerned States/UTs/Autonomous Organizations (KVS, NVS, CBSE, CISCE, AEES, MoD, EMRS under Ministry of Tribal Affairs etc.) will scrutinize all the entries and shortlist the candidates and forward the shortlisted to the chairperson of the awards committee along with minutes of the meeting. The State/UT/Autonomous Organization under MoE is to recommend as per given on annexure (attached) the number of shortlisted teachers, teacher educators.
4. Short listed candidates (teachers, teacher educators and states/UTs) are required to make presentations before the Awards Committee/Jury. Invitation in this regard will be sent to teachers/ teacher educators directly by CIET-NCERT with intimation to their directorate/organizations. **The composition of the Committee is as follows:**

1. Director, NCERT, New Delhi	Chairperson
2. DDG, NIC, New Delhi	Member
3. Representative from Secondary Education Bureau, Dept. of SE&L, MoE, GOI	Member
iv. Representative from Dept of IT, New Delhi	Member
v. Joint Director, CIET, New Delhi	Member Secretary

The awards committee recommends the requisite number of awardees to the Ministry with justification. The ministry further processes the recommendation for the awards. Each awardee teacher and teacher educators are awarded with a laptop and a commendation certificate. All winners form a community of resource persons through networking.

Principal Secretary / SPD/ Commissioner or any other competent authority on behalf of State/UT are required to nominate their State/ UT at **https://ictaward.ncert.gov.in** portal with supporting documents by using credentials provided by CIET. At CIET-NCERT, the SPDs or their representatives would be required to present their ICT related work of their State/ UT in the form of PowerPoint presentation to the Jury for final selection.

The Ministry of Education (MoE), Government of India, invites nominations for the National ICT Award for school teachers, teacher educators and States/UTs, for the year 2020 and 2021, from all States/UTs and Autonomous Educational Institutions under MoE and MoD. In all, 36 ICT Awards are instituted for teachers. From 2021 onwards two new categories of awards are introduced that are for teacher educators (10 awards) and best practicing states/UTs (3 awards). The scheme proposes to felicitate those teachers, teacher educator and best practicing States and UTs that have contributed in enhancing student learning by effectively and innovatively integrating technology supported learning into the school curriculum and subject teaching, and thereby promote enquiry-based cooperative and collaborative learning using ICT.

Eligibility Criteria

- The contest is open to school teachers for the year 2020 and 2021 from all over India.
- From the year 2021 onward contest is open for teacher educators of BIETs, DIETs, CTEs, IASEs, SIEMAT, SCERT, SIEs, SIETs and collages, run by centre/ State Govt./ UT administration or private Institutions and SPDs/ Commissioner/ Education Secretaries of states/UTs for best practices of ICT by respective states/UTs.

Selection and Submission of Entry

- Only online application will be accepted. The process for submission of online applications is scheduled to start from 01st May 2022 through the website <http://ictaward.ncert.gov.in/>
- School teachers, teacher educators and SPD/ Commissioner/ Secretary of school education are requested to fill online form as per instructions on the website.
- The entries will be first evaluated by the concerned States/UTs and Autonomous organisations (KVS, NVS, CBSE, ICSE, AEES, Sainik Schools).
- Last date for online application by school teachers, teacher educators and SPDs of Samagra Shiksha in States/UTs on the portal is 30th June, 2022.
- The last date for States/UTs/ Organisation to evaluate nominations/ entries and forward applications to NCERT is 31st July, 2022.

शिक्षा मंत्रालय - भारत सरकार, सभी राज्यों/ केन्द्र शासित प्रदेशों के आधीन स्वायत्त शैक्षिक संस्थानों से राष्ट्रीय आईसीटी पुरस्कार 2020 और 2021 के लिए नामांकन आमंत्रित करते हैं। यह योजना अध्यापकों, शिक्षक प्रशिक्षकों और उत्तम प्रयासरत राज्यों/ केंद्र शासित प्रदेशों को प्रोत्साहित करने के लिए प्रस्तावित है, जिन्होंने विद्यालयी पाठ्यक्रम एवं विषय- शिक्षण प्रक्रिया को प्रभावशाली बनाने के लिए नवीन एकीकृत प्रौद्योगिकी का उपयोग कर विद्यार्थियों में आईसीटी के प्रति जिज्ञासा उत्पन्न की है, जिससे खोज आधारित सहायक और सहयोगपरक शिक्षण को बढ़ावा दिया गया है। प्रत्येक वर्ष के लिए शिक्षकों को दिए जाने वाले पुरस्कारों की कुल संख्या 36 है। वर्ष 2021 से पुरस्कारों की दो नई श्रेणियाँ शुरू की गयी है जिनमें 10 पुरस्कार आई सी टी का प्रभावी उपयोग करने वाले शिक्षक प्रशिक्षकों के लिए और 3 पुरस्कार आई सी टी का श्रेष्ठ प्रयोग करने वाले राज्यों/ केंद्र शासित प्रदेशों के लिए है।

योग्यता मानदंड

- यह प्रतियोगिता संपूर्ण भारत के विद्यालयों में कार्यरत शिक्षकों के लिए रखी गई है।
- वर्ष 2021 से यह प्रतियोगिता केंद्र/ राज्य सरकारों/ केंद्र शासित प्रदेशों के प्रशासन द्वारा संचालित महाविद्यालयों, विश्वविद्यालयों, BIETs, DIETs, CTEs, IASEs, SIEMAT, SCERT, SIEs, SIETs एवं निजी शिक्षक प्रशिक्षण संस्थानों में कार्यरत शिक्षक प्रशिक्षकों और राज्य परियोजना निदेशक/ शिक्षा सचिव/ आयुक्त के माध्यम से आईसीटी का श्रेष्ठ प्रयोग करने वाले राज्यों/ केंद्र शासित प्रदेशों के लिए भी रखी गई है।

चयन व प्रविष्टि जमा करना
