<u>CIRCULAR</u>

Sub: <u>Common Admission Test-II for Non-Plan Admissions to Classes X and XII for the Session 2022-23.</u>

This is in continuation of Circular No. DE.23(363)/Sch.Br./2022/401 dated 20-04-2022 on the above subject wherein detailed guidelines for Non Plan Admissions to Classes X and XII for the session 2022-23 were issued. Many parents are approaching the offices of Directorate of Education for admission of their wards to Classes X and XII in Schools under Directorate of Education. In this regard, it has been decided that one chance will be given to all such students who could not apply in response to the above mentioned Circular. The schedule for admission along with guidelines is as under:

Criteria for Admission:

a. For class XII: The applicant must have passed class XI from a recognised school as a regular student during 2021-22 with desired subjects. Moreover, he/she must have obtained the minimum marks in class X required for the stream opted by the applicant, as per given table:

- ➤ Students who have passed their Secondary Examination (Class X) from NIOS with 55% marks or above in aggregate of 5 main subjects are eligible for admission in Humanities without Skill Subjects while others are eligible for Humanities with Skill Subjects.
- ➤ Relaxation of 5% marks in any one of the three subjects mentioned for admission in a particular stream of class XII is to be given in respect of candidates belonging to the categories SC/ST/Minorities/OBC (Non Creamy Layer)/Kashmiri Migrants and those students having I/II/III positions in National Games.
- For Specially Abled Students, relaxation of 5% marks in all subjects mentioned for admission in particular stream of class XII is to be given.
- b. For class X: The applicant must have passed class IX from a recognised school as a regular student during 2021-22.

- 2. Children/Parents seeking admission to class X / XII may fill the attached registration form along with Admit Card and submit it in any school nearer to their residence. A proper acknowledgement of receipt should be provided to the applicant/parents.
- 3. The Heads of the schools will forward all the applications to the concerned DDE (Distt.) / Nodal Incharge by 20-07-2022 for issue of admit cards. Before forwarding the applications to the concerned DDE (District) / Nodal Incharge, Heads will ensure that all applicants fulfill the eligibility criteria for admission to Class X/XII.
- 4. DDEs (District) will fix the Nodal Centre(s) and depute Nodal Incharge(s) for the Common Admission Test-II (CAT-II) 2022-23.
- 5. The Heads of the Schools will also submit a consolidated report of registered applicants in the following format:

6. Age criteria for admission in these classes must be followed as per circular No.DE.23(363)/Sch.Br./2016/1553 dated 19-09-2016 and DE.40(20)EVG/IEDC/Circular/98/7109-8699 dated 06.01.2003.

However, the regular students who have passed previous class during 2021-22 from any Recognised Unaided Schools of Directorate of Education or local bodies of Delhi and having a valid SLC & mark sheet will be exempted from applicability of age appropriate criteria similar to admission of students of feeder schools under Plan Admission.

Further to this, Director of Education at his discretion may provide relaxation in upper age to any deserving student (not covered under existing provisions) on grounds such as disruption of studies due to death of either of the parents, prolonged illness of either of the parents/child or any trauma faced by the student. In such cases parents of the students are required to submit an application on the attached format to the Head of the school nearer to his/her residence along with supporting documents related to the grounds under which relief has been sought. Head of that school, after recording his/her comments regarding suitability for age relaxation will forward the case to the concerned DDE (Zone) along with all the relevant documents including application of the applicant. After examination, if case is found fit for age relaxation only then it be forwarded to School Branch through concerned district clearly recording recommendations of the DDE (Zone). Such applicants may be allowed to appear in the Common Admission Tests but their admission will be confirmed only after grant of age relaxation by Director Education.

Heads of the schools are hereby directed to counsel/guide students, whose application is not found fit for age relaxation, to get admission in Patrachar Vidyalaya/NIOS.

- 7. The DDE (District) will issue admit cards (as per attached format) only to the eligible student (as per above mentioned eligibility criteria) after scrutinizing all the applications submitted by Heads of Schools. Photograph of the applicant pasted on Admit Card should be attested by the concerned DDE (Distt.) / Nodal Incharge.
- 8. The admit cards to all the eligible applicants will be distributed on 22-07-2022 in the schools where the applicants got registered themselves. Therefore, concerned Heads of Schools will ensure that duly signed admit cards are collected timely from the office of the concerned DDE (Distt.) / Nodal Officer.
- 9. The Test Paper for CAT-II will comprise Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs). The candidates will provide answers in the Test Booklet itself.
- 10. Test Paper for CAT-II will be provided centrally by Examination Branch.
- 11. For smooth conduct of test, following directions are to be complied with:
 - ➤ For Class X, Question Booklet will consist of five subjects: English (20 marks), Hindi (20 marks), Science (20 marks), Social Studies (20 marks) & Maths (20 marks).
 - For Class XII Subject wise Question Booklet will be provided to the applicant. Test will be conducted stream wise in the following subjects:
 - ✓ For Commerce Stream: English (25 marks), Maths (25 marks), Accountancy (25 marks) & Economics (25 marks).

Note: For Commerce without Maths, Maths will not be considered.

✓ For Science Stream: English (25 marks), Maths (25 marks), Physics (25 marks), Biology (25 marks) & Chemistry (25 marks).

Note: For Science without Maths, Maths will not be considered. For Science without Biology, Biology will not be considered.

✓ For Humanities Stream: English (25 marks), Hindi (25 marks), Pol. Science (25 marks), Economics (25 marks), History (25 marks) & Geography (25 marks).

Note: For class XII, it is mandatory to attempt any one language along with other three elective subjects.

- > Student will be declared pass in CAT only if he/she secures minimum 33% marks in each of the subjects separately as well as in aggregate.
- Applicants are advised to carry any photo ID card e.g. Aadhaar Card, Voter ID Card, School ID Card issued by previous school etc. in the examination centre for their identification.

- > Applicants are advised to carry any photo ID card e.g. Aadhaar Card, Voter ID Card, School ID Card issued by previous school etc. in the examination centre for their identification.
- > Heads of Schools are directed to disseminate this information to all the candidates and their parents at the time of submission of the application forms.
- 12. Result of the Common Admission Test for Classes X and XII will be declared on 27-07-2022 at 12:00 Noon and will be displayed in District Office. The same will also be forwarded to all the concerned Heads of Schools. The school will be allotted by the concerned DDE (District) as per vacancy/availability of subject combination in the school and residence of the applicant.
- 13. It has been noticed that some invalid combination of subjects are being offered to the students which is creating problem at CBSE/University level. All Head of schools are directed to offer those subjects which are in line with CBSE Guidelines as well as applicable at university level. In case of any query, the HoS may contact CBSE for clarification.
- 14. Concerned HoS will process & submit the files along with countersigned copies of documents for Class X & Class XII **separately** to concerned DDE (District) for approval and generation of Student ID.
- 15. The file must contain the details on the note sheet as per the following format:

- 16. The concerned HoS will ensure that the countersigned copies of the required documents are attached in the file before forwarding it to the concerned DDE (District).

 - Domicile certificate of the child or any of the parents.
 - Voter I card of any of the parents or child.
 - Electricity bill/MTNL telephone bill/Water bill.
 - Bank Passbook in the name of child or any of the parents.
 - Aadhaar number of the child or any of the parents.
 - Passport in the name of child or any of the parents.

- 18. Documents required for approval of DDE (District) for admission of a student in Class XII.

 - (iv) Result of Common Admission Test for Class XII.
 - (v) School Leaving Certificate of Class XI/XII of a recognized school.
 - (v) Anyone of the documents as residence proof of Delhi as stated at above mentioned point 17 (iv).
- 19. After approval of the admission by concerned DDE (District), student ID will be generated at DDE (District) level.
- 20. The DDE (District) will convey the approval of the admission to the concerned HoS.
