CIRCULAR

Sub:- Schedule of Delhi State School Games (Chess) for the year 2022-23

In continuation of Circular No. DE.41/Sports/2022/2102-2151 dated 29.07.2022, Sports Branch, Directorate of Education, Govt. of NCT of Delhi will conduct Delhi State School Games for the year 2022-23 in the discipline of Chess w.e.f. 23<sup>rd</sup> December 2022 to 28<sup>th</sup> December 2022. These tournaments will be conducted in three age groups i.e. Under-14, 17 & 19 years (Boys & Girls).

All the participants are hereby directed to bring their entries in the prescribed Performa (Annexure-I & II), available at department's website [www.edudel.nic.in](http://www.edudel.nic.in) duly attested by the concerned Secretary/Convener/Supervisor/HOS till 22.12.2022 at Chhatrasal Stadium, Model Town, Delhi-110009.

The stamp of the Head of the school on the Performa should be clearly visible and legible. The stamp on the photo of the student should have been affixed in such a manner that the half of it should be on the photo and half on the Performa. The players will have to report in the proper playing kit.

Reporting Time for participants: -

Age Group (Boys & Girls)	Date	Reporting time

Under 17 years	24.12.2022	10:00 AM
Under 19 years	24.12.2022	01:00 PM

Cutoff date of age group is as under: -

Age Group (Boys & Girls)	Eligibility
Under 14 years	Should be born on or after 01.01.2009
Under 17 years	Should be born on or after 01.01.2006
Under 19 years	Should be born on or after 01.01.2004

The participant should be a student of up to Class XII but not below Class VI.


**Instructions for Participation:**

1. The students of Kendriya Vidyalaya and those studying in below Class VI are not eligible to participate in the above completion.
2. The copy of birth certificate of the student, issued by Municipal Authority within 1 year from the D.O.B of student/player, is to be enclosed. In case of non-availability

- of birth certificate, the student will also have to furnish details of his educational qualification from nursery onwards in the Performa enclosed at Annexure-II.
3. In case of need, a student might have to undergo medical examination for age verification from the Govt. hospital.
  4. In case of any dispute, protest can be lodged with protest fees of Rs. 500/-, within one hour of completion of the event. No request would be allowed after the stipulated time.
  5. Participant must possess a valid AADHAR number.
  6. Decision of the Technical Committee would be final.
  7. A student can participate in only one age category in a particular year.
  8. The participant must carry proof of his/her date of birth certificate, original school ID card and a copy of bank passbook on the date of competition.
  9. The participant must follow all COVID specific instructions and shall bring with himself a self-declaration form on the date of the competition.

#### Rules and Regulations

1. The tournament will be played in 3 sections (separately for boys and girls) in each category. The participant shall bring their own chess boards.
2. Latest FIDE laws shall be observed to conduct the tournament unless otherwise, mentioned in these rules.
3. Total number of rounds will be decided only after receiving all the entries. No entries shall be entertained after the last date i.e., 22.12.2022.
4. A maximum of 5 players (Boys & Girls) can participate in each category.
5. Walk-over time shall be 30 minutes from start of the game.
6. Use of mobile phones and other electronic devices is strictly prohibited during the game. If a player's mobile rings during the game or if a mobile is found with him/her in 'SWITCH ON' mode, the point will be awarded to the opponent and the player with the mobile will be declared lost.
7. Parents/coaches/school representatives are not allowed in the tournament hall.
8. Arbiter's decision will be final and binding to all the players.
9. Any sort of misbehavior on the part of the players/parents or school representative will result in the expulsion of the participant/school from the tournament.
