Note 1: The upper age-limit is relaxable for departmental candidate upto 40 years in accordance with the instructions or orders issued by the Central Government. Note 2: The crucial date for determining the age-limit shall be as advertised by the DSSSB/ Competent Authority.
7.	Educational and other Qualification required for Direct Recruits	Essential : 1. Bachelors Degree in Chemistry from a recognized University. 2. One year experience in the Analysis or Testing of organic or inorganic materials from a recognized University or scientific institution of Archaeological Department or Museum. Note 1 : Qualifications are relaxable at the discretion of the Competent Authority, for reasons to be recorded in writing, in the case of candidates otherwise well qualified. Note 2 : The qualifications regarding experience is/are relaxable at the discretion of the Competent Authority in the case of candidates belonging to scheduled castes and Scheduled Tribes If, at any stage of selection, the Competent Authority is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancies reserved from them.
