1	Beret Cap	Khaki coloured, lined with black color polyester cloth. The black color polypropylene tape of 25 +/-2 mm shall be attached to the bettom edge of the bevel by one row of stitches, turned over and Joined to the body by an additional row of stitches. The channel so formed shall be around 13 mm and provided with a braided polyester draw tape approximately 18 cm longer than the circumference of the head band. Two metal eyelets of 6 mm size shall be litted at the back approximately 25 mm apart and 20 mm above the bottom edge of the "beret". The eyelet shall be black in	
2	K.D.Shirt	Full Sleeves, shall have a curvature at bottom on both sides to adjust the wrinkles. To be provided with attached collar 2 %" to 3" wide with 7 buttons along the front pleat. Shoulder loops for badges with a variable width i.e. 2" from shoulder stitch to 1 %" at collar stitch fastened with a button at collar stitch. Two chest pockets 5 ½" to 6" deep and 4 %" to 5 ½" wide with a 1 ½" box pleat in the centre fastened at the top with a small button to the flap which should be provided with a small button hole. One epaulette of 1 ½" for name plate over both pocket. The flap of pocket shall have three pointed edges each of 2 ¾" to 3" length at left, right and centre of the flap, edges connected to each other with curve having a depth of 1 ¾" to 2". The left, right & centre edge shall have chit & normal button respectively to secure the flap smartly. Full sleeves with single cuff 2 ½" wide and secured with one button, which shall be folded in summers having a length of 7" to 9" from shoulder stitch.	OZ Nos.
