The survey is being done by the NGO, Dream a Dream through data collection on behalf of OECD. The NGO coordinators of this survey are Mr. Ankush (9555535635) and Ms. Apoorva (9654771725)

Thus, the concerned HoSs of the 75 listed Government schools are directed to nominate a teacher who will act as School Coordinator and to cooperate with the coordinators of the NGO in data collection from their schools.

The above said permission is given with the following terms and conditions:

1. The schools working should not be disrupted. The safety and security of the students should be ensured.
2. Financial aid will not be provided by the Directorate of Education to the concerned Organization or to any person. Moreover no foreign funding should be involved in the project without the prior approval of DoE and following the guidelines issued by GoI.
3. Privacy of students/parents should not be affected in the process of project.
4. Material will not show any kind of advertisement i.e. name, sign, logo, sponsorship and material should not be distributed by any Celebrity.
5. There shall be no uploading of the image/pictures/video of the students on social media pages except with the prior written permission of the Director (Education).
6. Organizations have to ensure that no damages occur while conducting the program. It will be the sole responsibility of the Organization and it should rectify to the entire satisfaction of the HoS if there is any damage.
7. The permission is purely provisional and liable to be withdrawn at any time if it is found to be against the national interest or causes any type of obstruction in the functioning of DoE as well as violation of these terms and conditions.
8. The DoE will indemnify against any legal/financial liability/litigation that may arise out of the project process or its findings.
9. Ensure that the Covid-19 protocol is being followed strictly.
10. The Safety and security of the students should be ensured

I am writing to you with regard to the participation of the Delhi Government in the 2nd cycle of the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) Survey on Social and Emotional Skills (SSES).

This Survey is one of the first international efforts to develop a comprehensive set of metrics around social and emotional skills designed to enhance policies to improve the development and well-being of young people. The goal of this assessment is to gather empirical evidence on students' social and emotional skills and their relevance to various life outcomes along with providing robust and reliable insights.

The survey would target students (15 years old), teachers, principals, and parents. As per the international timelines of the study, we are to conduct the main study in April-May 2023. The field trial was conducted last year in May 2022.

Sub: Request for permission to conduct data collection in 75 schools as part of the Study on Social and Emotional survey by OECD (Organisation of Economic Cooperation and Development) with Dream a Dream as the national partner, from April 27th to May 6th 2023

Respected Sir,

We are writing to seek permission for the data collection for a multi-year survey on social and emotional skills (SES), organised by the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD). The survey is being done by the NGO, Dream a Dream through data collection on behalf of the OECD.

The goal of this study is to collect empirical evidence on the social and emotional skills of 15-year-old adolescents and their relationship to various life outcomes that supports improving policies to improve the development and well-being of children and young people. The Survey accomplishes this by testing various social and emotional skills and gathering detailed information about students' environments.

This year, India (Delhi) is one of 15 countries taking part in the Survey of Social-Emotional Skills, alongside Bogota (Colombia), Bulgaria, Turin & Emilia Romagna (Italy), Dubai (UAE), Gunma (Japan), Helsinki (Finland), Chile, Ji Nan (China), Kudus (Indonesia), Mexico, Peru, Spain, Sobral (Brazil), and Ukraine.

With regards to the circular no Addl. DE/Misc./2022/620-623, a pilot survey was conducted last year. In continuation of the same, a survey for 75 schools is proposed to be conducted this year for which the data collection process requires 7 working days. For which the suggested dates are- **27th of April 2023 and end on 6th of May 2023**. During this period, the test administrators shall visit the schools for data collection from students, teachers and principals.

As a part of SES, the following surveys will be administered:

- 1) Student Assessment and Questionnaire: to be completed by every student sampled in each participating school)
- 2) Teacher Questionnaire: to be completed by sampled teachers of the grades that 15-year-old and students attend in participating schools
- 3) Principal Questionnaire: to be completed by one school principal of each participating school.



The survey is done for students who are between the age of 15 years and 3 months to 16 years and 2 months (as of 12th April 2023). The coordinators of this survey are Ms Apoorva (9654771725) and Mr Ankush (9555535635).

The schools are selected through sampling by OECD. The detailed list of schools is attached as Annexure 1.

Before the field work starts, we would require the following:-

Each school to nominate one teacher from the school who will act as the 'School Coordinator'. The details for the same (Names, contact details and school information) are to be entered in the following link <https://forms.gle/nXPKaHDirjM2taZu6> by 26th April 2023.

The school coordinator will be responsible for the following:-

- a) To coordinate with the test administrators appointed for their respective school
- b) To ensure the proper administration of the instruments that make up the SSES Survey
- c) Coordinators are to share the date and timing for the data collection and any immediate concerns in advance.
- d) Prepare survey administration in the school (IT resources, staffing, suitable room, tracking forms, distribution and collection of Teacher and Principal Questionnaires, etc.)
- e) Assist Test Administrator (TA) in administering the Student Assessment and Questionnaire on the assessment day
- f) Furthermore, the school coordinators are also requested to support the test administrators to collect academic scores of the last exam given by the students (March 2023) and fill out a spreadsheet link.

Kindly allow us to conduct the study in the sampled schools. The study expenses will be borne by Dream a Dream. The Directorate of Education will have no financial implications. It will be ensured that the confidentiality of the schools, students and teachers is maintained throughout the study. The results will be disseminated only after prior approval of the Directorate of Education.

We request you to kindly accord your permission so that this data collection can be initiated at the earliest.
