Sub: Prevention and Control of Vector Borne Diseases (Dengue, Chikungunya & Malaria).

In view of early onset of Monsoon this year and water logging in Delhi, there are chances of significant increase in the number of dengue cases this year. Therefore, all necessary preventive measures are required to be implemented at the earliest.

Since, Aedes aegypti mosquito, the vector for dengue virus, is generally active during day time and commonly bites on ankles and elbows and the fact that the incidence of acute dengue fever is higher in children. Hence the clothing worn by the school going children should be such that both their upper and lower limbs are covered and unexposed.

In line of the above all HoSs of Govt. / Govt. Aided and Pvt. Unaided Recognized Schools under DoE, GNCTD are hereby directed to

- 1. Distribute Dengue Homework Card (DHC) to each and every student of the school.
- 2. Ensure that Dengue Homework Card (DHC) cards should be checked and signed by the class teacher / nodal teacher on a weekly basis. The same may be discussed with parent at the time of PTM.
- 3. Allow students to either wear uniform comprises of full sleeves shirts/blouse & trouser/skirts with slacks or allow the students to wear mufti comprises of full sleeves shirt/ blouse & trouser/slacks till November, 2023.
- 4. Awareness sessions/ other activities for prevention and control of Vector Borne Diseases in schools may be continued.
- 5. District VBD officers may be contacted for coordination with reference to prevention and control of VBDs. You are requested to facilitate the District VBD officer, in case they want to visit schools/ undertake some activity in the schools.
- 6. Pictorials and Handouts may be distributed among the students and display on the notice board of the school.
- 7. Recorded audio massages regarding awareness of Dengue may be played through mic system. Provided by DDE (District and Zones).

All HoSs of Govt., Govt. Aided and Pvt. Unaided Recognized Schools under DoE, GNCTD are hereby directed to share the awareness instructions already given in the circular No. DE.23 (386)/Sch.Br./SHP/2023-24/166-172 dated 30.06.2023 with the students and school staff to follow at home and also the needful to be done by all HoSs at school level.

Further, Heads of Schools are directed to submit the compliance report to DDE (Zone/District) by 24/07/2023.



REMEMBER

Empty the water cooler every week or put some oil/petrol in it.



Always cover the bucket, water tank, other utensils properly



Don't throw broken utensils, bottles, tin, tires and coconut shells or disposables in the open




Wear full sleeves and use mosquito repellants.



Use net at home and hospitals during fever regularly.




