As you may be aware, the Ministry of Education recognizes the contributions of exceptional teachers and awards them on an annual basis to celebrate the unique contributions of teachers in the country and to honor those teachers who through their commitment have not only improved the quality of school education but also enriched the lives of their students.

It is imperative to recognize the NAT Awardee Teachers and use their expertise through various interventions to strengthen the Education Ecosystem. We may tap into their wealth of knowledge, experience, and best practices to enhance teaching and learning outcomes.
- In this regard, this Department proposes the following interventions which may enhance the integration of the national awardees into the larger education ecosystem, allowing them to create an even more profound impact and strengthen the education system further with their efficient engagement. The interventions are listed below:

Leading Communities of Practice - Each awardee can be entrusted with conducting a monthly Professional Learning Circle (PLC) in their cluster with 30-40 teachers. Every PLC shall be a space for teachers to discuss current classroom challenges and brainstorm possible solutions together as professionals. Awardee teachers may lead the circle and facilitate active sharing and learning. This practice, over time, will enable a community to be developed in the cluster and create an on-ground opportunity for the awardee to share their expertise and motivate other teachers in their circle towards the same.

Ensuring involvement and engagement of awardee teachers in all consultative and taskbased committees - Awardees should be allowed to represent teachers' needs and ideas in various committees like textbook and curriculum development committees, consultative meetings for new schemes and interventions in school education, etc. The group of awarded teachers can act as a ready database of teachers who can be invited to participate in workshops and meetings. The awardees may be involved in various committees at different levels starting from SCERT, State level, National level, by various autonomous bodies like NCTE, NCERT, CBSE etc.

- c. Documenting their expertise Awardees can be encouraged to write two-three case studies based on their area of need and knowledge. The case studies can then be used made a part of Vidya Amrit Portal. DIETs can conduct a district-level seminar where all awarded teachers from the district can present their case studies as working papers.
- d. Linking NAT with NPST The awardee teacher may be given specific points in their selfevaluation for being a winner of the national award to teachers to facilitate faster and more

meaningful growth in terms of the various stages envisaged in the National Professional Standards for Teachers levels viz. Beginner, Proficient, Expert, and Lead Teacher. This connection may be a meaningful incentive for teachers and create more value for the award.

- e. Exposure Visit for Awardees national/international exposure visits may be planned for the awardees to enhance their skill set further and push their benchmark of excellence.
- f. To involve in District Level Education Planning: National Awardee teachers may take up leadership roles in district-level education planning committees or advisory boards. Their expertise and insights can shape policies, initiatives, and programs that directly impact teaching and learning within the district. This involvement will ensure that their voices are heard, and their experiences are utilized to drive positive change.
- 8. Organize Workshops and Consultations: Conduct workshops, consultations, or focus group discussions with National Awardee teachers to gather their feedback and suggestions on district education planning. These sessions can be designed to address specific challenges, discuss best practices, and brainstorm innovative solutions. Their participation will provide a valuable perspective that can enhance the effectiveness of education planning efforts.
- 9. Teacher Training Programs: Invite National Awardee Teachers to serve as Resource Person or facilitators in In-service teacher training programs. They can share their best practices, innovative teaching methods, and pedagogical insights with fellow teachers.
