The selected students/players will represent Delhi in 67th National School Games 2023-24 (U-14 Boys & Girls) to be held at Lucknow (Uttar Pradesh) w.e.f. 16th Dec 2023 to 20th Dec 2023, (U-19 Boys & Girls) to be held at Chandrapur (Maharashtra) w.e.f. 26th Dec 2023 to 30th Dec 2023 under the aegis of SGFI.

The player U-14 age category should be born on or after <u>01/01/2010</u> and U-19 age category should be born on or after <u>01/01/2005</u> and should be studying in 12th class or below but not below 6th Standard.teh participating player must be a regular enrolled student of the school.

The student/ player who has passed 12th standard will not be eligible to participate in the SGFI NSGs games irrespective of being in any age category.

 The copy of birth certificate of the student, issued by the concerned Municipal Authority or the copy of Xth certificate mentioning Date of Birth issued by the concerned Board (CBSE/ICSE etc.) or the certificate from HOS/Principal of Govt. (In case of any age dispute the student may be subject to undergo medical examination for age verification from a Govt. Hospital.)

The team manager will be responsible for ensuring the submission of the eligibility and birth certificates of the participants to the organizing committee. Only the official entry forms signed by the competent authority of the State/UT/Unit will be considered acceptable. Failure to provide the signed official entry forms may result in ineligibility for participation in the tournament and the issuance of a merit/participation certificate.


