CIRCULAR

It is brought to the notice of all beneficiaries of DGEHS, serving & retirees of this department that;

- Only Authorized Medical Attendant is authorized to issue Non-Availability certificate to the serving employees for medicines, which are not available in the dispensary to which beneficiary is attached.
- In case of pensioner beneficiaries, Non-Availability certificate may be issued if medicines are not available in Delhi Government Dispensary/Hospital to which beneficiary is attached and not provided by the Authorized chemist nominated for the concerned health facility.

As such all the medical reimbursement claims of medicines should invariably accompany along with the NON-AVAILABILITY certificate issued by the authorities as mentioned above. Claims with Non-Availability certificate from any other sources shall not be acceptable for reimbursement.

This issue as per the provisions under CS (MA) rules, 1944 and instruction of DGEHS.
