

Delhi is facing peak summers with temperatures touching almost 49 degrees in several parts of the city. This has led to a major water crisis in Delhi. Every day, with soaring temperatures, the demand for water is also constantly increasing. Despite its best efforts, the Delhi Jal Board is struggling to meet the peaking demand for water in the national capital.

Given the situation, it has come to my notice that water supply will be shut down in several areas of Delhi for 24 hours starting from 10 am on 29.05.2024 to 10 am on 30.05.2024 due to shifting of 200mm dia air valves on 1500mm dia twin raw water main feeding to Dwarka WTP near Karala-Kanjhawala Road by NHAI. The affected areas include colonies with dense population such as Mahavir Enclave, Dwarka Sub-city, Vijay Enclave, Uttam Nagar group of Colonies, Pochan Pur, Bharthal, Amberahi Village, Madhu Vihar, Sagarpur, Kailash Puri, Durga Park, Mangla Puri, Raj Nagar Phase 1&2, Bagdola Village, Bijwasan, Dhulisiras, Bindapur, Sewak Park, Bharat Vihar, Sita Puri, Raja Puri, Jiwan Park, Indira Park, Milap Nagar and Chanakya Place and adjoining Areas. These areas are already facing acute water shortage. Curtailing water supply for 24 hours in these areas will further intensify the problem.

The CEO is therefore directed that there will be no shutdown of water supply by the DJB for any project in any part of the city. All such activities where shutdown of water supply is required will be taken up only after the month of July.
