The stamp of the Head of the school on the Performa should be clearly visible and legible. The stamp on the photo of the student should have been affixed in such a manner that the half of it should be on the photo and half on the Performa. The players will have to report in the proper playing kit.

Instructions for Participation:-

- 1. The students of Kendriya Vidyalaya and those studying in below class VI are not eligible to participate in the above competition.
 - 2. The date of birth as mentioned on the disability certificate of the particular CWD participant shall be considered as final proof of age participation in the event.
 - 3. In case of need, a student might have to undergo medical examination for age verification from the Govt. hospital.
 - 4. 01st position holder at zonal level of each game shall participate in State level Para Sports Meet. However, if any district has single participation of CwD/CWSN in particular game, the same shall be nominated as direct felicitated owing to single disability criteria for State level.
- 5. In case of any dispute, protest can be lodged with protest fee of Rs. 500/- within one hour of completion of the event. No request would be allowed after the stipulated time.
- 6. Participant must possess a valid Aadhar number.
- 7. Decision of the Org. Secretary shall be final.
- 8. A student can participate in only one category in a particular year.
- CWDs of all 21 disability categories as stated in RPWD Act 2016 and possessing the disability certificate (40% and above) shall participate in activities as per their abilities.

- 10. The participant must carry proof of his/her date of birth certificate, original school ID card and a copy of bank passbook on the date competition.
- 11. Zonal convener/Secretary will prepare chest no at their own. It should be 8x6 inches in size of white colour and printed with red colours for girls in all age group and blue colour for boys in all age group.
 - 12. Chest No. will be allowed in this manner:-

For example: - Zone -I will start from 101 to 130 for Senior boys.

131 to 160 for Junior Boys

161 onwards for Sub Junior Boys.

- Similarly, Zone 2 will start from 201, Zone 03 will start from 301 and So On.
- Same chest no. will be allotted for girls but printed with red colour.
- One athlete can take part in maximum 03 events but chest no. will remain same.
- 16. Chest No. should be attached with T Shirt with 04 pins and clearly visible.
