**Subject: Regarding visit of students to Amrit Udyan at Rashtrapati Bhawan – 2024.**

With reference to the letter received from Dr. Rakesh Gupta (IAS) Addl. Secretary to the President on 8<sup>th</sup> August 2024 and subsequent meeting held in Rashtrapati Bhawan on 6<sup>th</sup> August 2024 regarding visit of students to Amrit Udyan at Rashtrapati Bhawan in which it is informed that Amrit Udyan is open to general public from 16/08/2024 to 15/09/2024 from 10:00 AM to 06:00 PM (last entry by 05:15 PM) everyday during this period except Mondays. Recommended visiting days for schools are Tuesday-Friday and entry time slots are 10:00 AM-11:00 AM, 11:00 AM-12:00 PM, 03:00 PM- 04:00 PM (the gardens will remain closed on Mondays.) The gardens will be reserved specially for Sports persons on 29<sup>th</sup> August 2024 and for teachers on 5<sup>th</sup> September 2024. Additionally, visit to Rashtrapati Bhawan Museum remains open free for students to explore the history of our nation. Booking can be done through online on website <https://rashtrapatibhawan.gov.in>.

Thus, all the HoSs of Govt. Schools of Delhi are hereby directed to send students of Class 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> for Amrit Udyan visits. The NOC is to be obtained from parents in advance and also to ensure that students visit in proper school uniform only. The HoSs will ensure that the students be accompanied by escorting teachers for the safety & securities of students..

The expenditure towards transportation and refreshment may be debited form the SMC Fund/PWF available with the school as per norms.

All the District DDE's are directed to designate a Coordinator preferably SPE and send their name & details by 12/08/2024 through mail to [amritudyanvisit@gmail.com](mailto:amritudyanvisit@gmail.com). for any query please contact Ms. Rumi Deori, OSD Science Branch (Ph: 9818619815). SPE's will facilitate the booking of visit of students from all Govt. Schools to Amrit Udyan.

There is also a vibrant food court where visitors can have refreshments.

Visit to Rashtrapati Bhavan Museum remains open to explore the history of our nation. Visitors can come and view Evolution of Rashtrapati Bhavan, and lives of various Presidents of India. There is no entry fee for students and faculties during this period.

## Instructions for School and College Visits

### **1. OPENING AND SUGGESTED DAYS / TIMINGS**

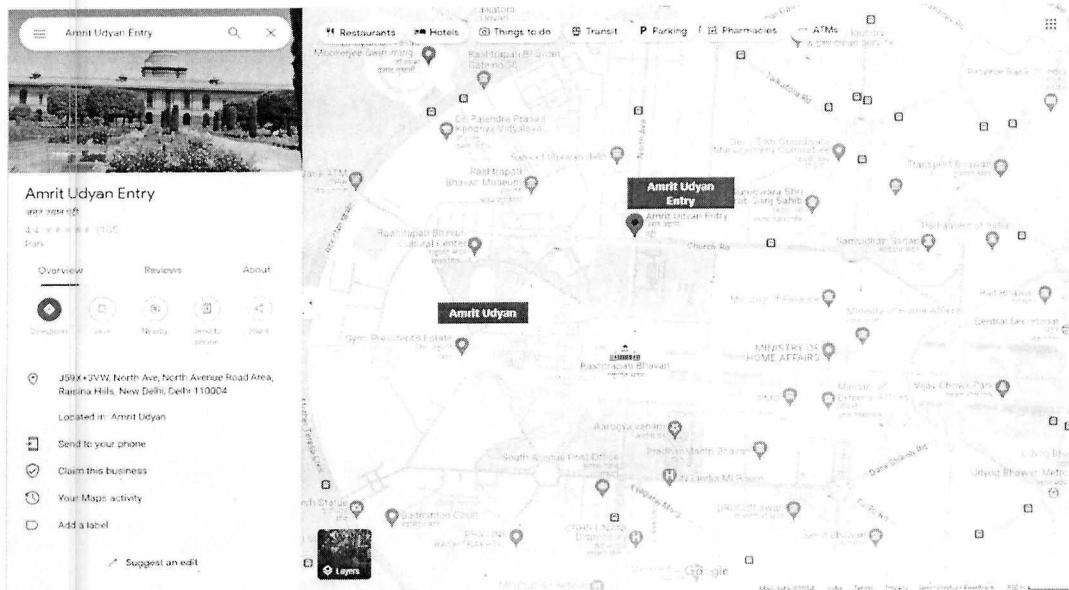
- The Gardens will remain open for the general public from 16th Aug to 15th Sept, 2024
- Garden will remain open from Tuesday - Sunday; recommended visiting days for schools and colleges are Tuesday - Friday
- Garden timings will be 10AM - 6PM; recommended entry time slots are 10AM - 11AM, 11AM - 12PM and 3PM - 4PM
- The Gardens will remain closed on Mondays
- The Gardens will be reserved specially for Sports persons on 29th Aug 2024 and for Teachers on 5th Sept 2024.

### **2. BOOKINGS AND CONFIRMATION**

- Schools and colleges will have three options to book their visits:
  - Online bookings on Rashtrapati Bhavan website (<https://rashtrapatibhavan.gov.in>) and follow the "Amrit Udyan" link in the "Visit" tab.
  - Email at [udyanutsav-rb@rb.nic.in](mailto:udyanutsav-rb@rb.nic.in)
  - Call on +91-9205855997
- Schools and colleges interested in visiting Rashtrapati Bhavan Museum can additionally book their slots for the Museum as well. Tickets are free for students. Students can make the most of this learning opportunity.
- Post completion of booking, a confirmation will be shared with respective schools and colleges
- Confirmation will have a QR coded entry ticket that may be used during entry
- Maximum 50 students can be registered on a single booking. In case the number of students is more than 50, a separate booking needs to be done.
- Schools may ensure that students visit the Gardens in proper school uniform only

### 3. ENTRY PROCESS

- Entry to Gardens will be through Gate No. 35 of the Rashtrapati Bhavan on North Avenue Road (outlined in the map below)
- Schools and colleges are required to arrive at the entry gate as per time slot booked by them
- Each accompanying teacher shall carry the booking QR code on their phones to facilitate the entry of students

# Amrit Udyan - 2024

## Brief Primer for School and College Visits

### BACKGROUND

The Amrit Udyan will remain open to the general public from 16th Aug to 15th Sept, 2024. Last year, the Summer Annuals edition of the Amrit Udyan was opened up to the public for the first time in history. The upcoming edition has even more exciting elements for the visitors to explore.

This edition of the flowering extravaganza will especially focus on welcoming school and college students, and give them a glimpse of Amrit Udyan, the gardens of Rashtrapati Bhavan. This document is being shared with institutes to enable faculties to brief students about what they can expect to see on their visit to Amrit Udyan.

We hope this primer will help build excitement among our young visitors about their trip to Amrit Udyan.

### KEY ATTRACTIONS

#### 1. Bal Vatika

*A dedicated garden specially for children which includes swings and slides, a Nature's trail, a babbling brook and a Treehouse. Adjacent to it is the section on Birds of Rashtrapati Bhavan.*

#### 2. Theme Garden

*A dedicated garden with specially curated display of Summer Annuals*

*Blend of multiple shades – Coleus, Celosia, Tuberosa and many other rare seasonal flowers in full glory*

#### 3. Bonsai Garden

*Set up in 2010 with around 360 Bonsai plants. Varieties include Ficus Infactoria, Ficus Panda, etc.*

#### 3. East Lawn & Central Lawn

*Consists of flower beds, fountains, water channels, terraces and. These flower beds are planted with 120 varieties of roses, and 70 varieties of seasonal flowers.*

#### 4. Long Garden

*Consists of rectangular and square-shaped rose beds of different varieties. Creepers along the side walls blossom with flowers in different colors. Complementing them are shrubs of Choti Narangi.*

#### 5. Circular Garden

*Consists of fragrant varieties such marigold, viola, and pansies. A bubble fountain in the middle enhances the grandeur of the garden. Home to more than 25 varieties of seasonal flowers*

## **6. Vertical Garden**

*An interesting picture point with myriads of plants, artistically arranged vertically.*

## **7. Nature's Classroom**

*Two nature classrooms formed from the logs of an old tree which completed its life. Many student activities will be organized under the shade of the magnificent Pilkhan tree.*

## **8. Musical Fountains**

*Artistic fountains perfectly synchronized with classical tunes of shehnai, veena and patriotic songs and surrounded by majestic Banyan Trees*
