CIRCULAR

Subject- Organization of **DISTRICT LEVEL Kala Utsav** leading to participation at State and National Level for all Govt., Govt. Aided Schools/Recognized Private Schools under Directorate of Education.

Kala Utsav, a flagship programme of the Department of School Education and Literacy, Ministry of Education(MoE) was launched in 2015. Kala Utsav aims to foster and showcase the artistic talent of the student of Secondary Stage. This annual event provides a platform for students to explore and celebrate arts and cultural diversity at various levels-school, district, state and national.

In Kala Utsav 2024, there will be a few changes which will foster growth, flexibility and widen the scope of the whole event. Theme of this Kala Utsav will be: Viksit Bharat-A Vision for Bharat in the year-2047. The art forms have been grouped in many sub-categories under six broad categories-1. Vocal Music 2. Instrumental Music 3. Dance 4. Theatre 5. Visual arts 6. Traditional Story Telling

All District Coordinators appointed by District DDEs are directed to organize Kala Utsav competitions in their respective **Districts tentatively** between **18.11.2024** to **20.11.2024** and submit the result latest by **22.11.2024** to the office of the undersigned.

The State level Kala Utsav is tentatively scheduled to be held from 26.11.2024 to 28.11.2024.

4	Theatre	Drama Group	Maximum 5 Students (Mixed Group)	6-8 minutes	 Performance can be in any regional form of modern theatre, integrating glimpses from the life of any personality, i.e. eminent social reformer, artist, writer, poet, scientist or freedom fighter of your sate or region, in any language or dialect of any region. Costume, stage setting, props etc. will be arranged by the teams themselves.
5	Traditional Story Telling	Story Telling (One /Two participants)	One team of 1 or 2 students	Max 5 minutes	 Incorporating Dance, Drama, Music or Visual Arts or more than one art form One or Two participants will tell the story Any dialect or language (with a Summary in English/Hindi) Costumes, makeup, props and music of individual choice.

- 1. Total Number of Art Form Categories-6
- 2. Students of classes IX,X,XI & XII (9th to 12th) of all Government, Government Aided and Private School.
- 3. Winners (I, II and III position) of the National Level of the previous year of Kala Utsav are not allowed to participate in National Level Kala Utsav -2024-25. Therefore they are not allowed to participate at the Districts Level also.
- 4. A team comprising of 3 Judges (One Set of Judges) should be engaged per event.
- 5. One student can participate **only in one event**.
- 6. Participation of Socio-Economically Disadvantaged Group (SEDG) including Children with Special Needs (CWSN) at all levels to be ensured.
- 7. **Textual Summary Write-up-** (Required to be submitted by the winners of State Level only) Should not be more than **100 words** in Hindi or English to be prepared by the participants by himself/herself giving details about the selected art form. The textual summary can be supported with Photographs (Max-5).
- 8. District wise compiled result of all the events of Kala Utsav (Hard Copies and Soft Copies) and other required documents must be submitted to the office of the Physical Education Branch, Chhatrasal Stadium, Model Town, Delhi, latest by 30.10.2024 (tentative date).
- 9. In State level Kala Utsav Competition 2024-25, only **1**st **position holders** of all the events from **12 Districts** will participate.
- 10. The List of District Coordinators is enclosed as Annexure-I.
- 11. All DDE Districts must ensure maximum participation in the event
