ORDER

It has been brought to my notice that whenever a prisoner is not produced before the Court because of illness or any other reason the written communication in this regard is not promptly sent to the concerned Court by Superintendent Jail. This is highly objectionable and tantamount to interference in the administration of justice as non production lead to delayed trial.

The Superintendent Jails are therefore directed to personally ensure that the concerned courts are duly informed through written communication about non production of a prisoner along with the reasons so that next date of production is duly conveyed to them by Court. This communication should be promptly sent so that it may reach the concerned court by 10 AM. Further, Superintendent Jails should ensure that next date of production is obtained from the concerned trial court whenever accused is not sent to the Court.

This should be scrupulously followed by all Superintendent Jails.
