Para 9(1) may be substituted by the following:-

The normal number of chances for Part-I of the Junior Accounts Officer (Common) Examination will be six for general candidates and eight for candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe subject to the condition that the candidate should not have attained the age of 53 years on the 1st of April, in which the training is proposed to be started. Indefinite number of chances in Part-I shall, however, be allowed to those candidates who secure 30% or more marks in the aggregate in any one of the last two consecutive Examinations actually written by them, provided they have not attained the age of 53 years on the 1st of April in which the training is proposed to be held. There will be no such limit on the number of chances for the IIInd part of S.A.S./Junior Accounts Officer (Common) Examination.
