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(C) This Administration has already constituted its own Accounts Service and Rules thereof, have since been notified. These Rules also provide the absorption of the officials who are at present on deputation to the Administration subject to their consent. Taking into account the anticipated absorption of about 25% officials depending upon their willingness and suitability, repatriation of deputationists after expiry of their terms, retirement and anticipated expansion etc. etc. the number of anticipated vacancies repatriation/ superannuation during the next 10 years will be as follows :-

The extension has been assessed on the basis of anticipated creation of one post of A.O and 4 posts of S.A.S Acctt every year. Thus the total additional creation of posts during the open of 1983-93 may be 11 posts of A.Os and 44 posts of J.A.Os/S.A.S Acctts. The total anticipated strength at the end of the year 1993 may thus be 74 and 244 J.A.Os/S.A.S Accountants.

(4) NEED OF TRAINING IN DELHI

This Administration, therefore, has decided to start training and to conduct examination in both parts of S.A.S Examination in the Union Territory of Delhi. The training will initially be arranged through the Controller of Accounts Delhi Administration.

(5) ELIGIBILITY FOR TRAINING

(1) Officials of Subordinate Services who are in the scale of Rs. 425-700 and also the Sr. Stenographers who are in the scale of Rs. 425-700 will be eligible for training, subject to the condition that they are not more than 50 years of age and have rendered at least 3 years of service in the scale of Rs. 425-700 as on 1st April of the year in which the training is proposed to be held.
