

(9) NUMBER OF CHANCES

i) Not more than 6 chances will be allowed for passing S.A.S (Part-I) Examination while there will be no such limit on the number of chances for the ~~1st Part~~ of the S.A.S Examination.

ii) An official who fails in the examination will be allowed to appear in the subsequent examination but will not be allowed to attend the training course for that part of the Examination in which he fails.

(10) EXEMPTION

A candidate with exemption in ~~three~~ subjects of S.A.S (Part-I) Examination will be allowed to appear simultaneously in the fourth subject of Part-I along with S.A.S (Part-II) Examination of Delhi Administration.

(11) LANGUAGE MEDIUM

i) The question paper for the S.A.S Examination except the two mentioned in the succeeding paragraph will be set in English and must be answered in English.

ii) The question papers on the subject "Prelis & Drafting and "Constitution of India" Part-I of the Examination will be set in English as well as Hindi. At the time of applying for training/examination the candidate must exercise his option to take these papers in Hindi or in English. It is essential that these options must be exercised at the time of applying for training and later on. Option once exercised shall be final and no request for change of option will be entertained. The option should be exercised for the subject as a whole i.e. candidates are not allowed to answer some questions pertaining to the same subject in Hindi and other in English.

(12) EXAMINATION

Examination of both parts of S.A.S Examination will be conducted by the Controller of Accounts, Government of India, Ministry of Finance, New Delhi.

13 APPOINTMENTS

i) The passing of both the parts of the S.A.S Examination will make an official eligible for appointment as S.A.S Accountant/Jr. Accounts Officer but the actual appointment will be made depending upon the vacancies available.

ii) The appointment of the officials who qualify the Second Part of the S.A.S Examination in a particular batch of training will be made in the order of their seniority in the subordinate service Cadre/Stenographer cadre.
