

iii) The seniority in the S.A.S Accountants cadre will be reckoned with reference to the date of passing the examination vis-à-vis the seniority of the official in the Subordinate Service Cadre/Stenographer Cadre irrespective of the marks secured by the official in S.A.S Examination.

iv) The list of successful candidates after passing Part-II will be supplied by the Controller General of Accounts, Govt. of India, Ministry of Finance to the Service Department of Delhi Administration who will arrange the same in the order of seniority in the Subordinate Service Cadre/Stenographer Cadre and thereafter forward the same to the Finance Department Delhi Administration, which will arrange their posting against available vacant posts in the Accounts Cadre. The subsequent management of the Accounts Cadre would be entirely with the Finance Department, Delhi Administration, in respect of posting, transfer, seniority, promotion etc. etc.

(14) LECTURES

i) A time table will be prepared by the Controller of Accounts, Delhi Administration indicating the daily periods, subjects of training programme for one batch, based on the requirement of the syllabus for each paper in the S.A.S Examination. Guest lecturers will also be provided/arranged by the Controller of Accounts, Delhi Administration for each subject and the total duration of training.

(15) REMUNERATION

The remuneration for lectures will be such as may be decided by the Delhi Administration on from time to time. Similarly the rate of remuneration for conduct of S.A.S (Part-I) & (Part-II) Examination will be such as may be decided by the Controller General of Accounts, Govt. of India, Ministry of Finance, New Delhi.

(16) BOOKS

It will be responsibility of the trainees to arrange for the books and stationery as may be required by them for the training. No payment on account of purchase of stationery etc. will be made from the Government account. In the case of books the cost of official publication used by the candidates will be borne as follows :-

i)	Rebate allowed by the Directorate of publication	25%
ii)	Cost to be borne by the Delhi Admn.	25%
iii)	Cost to be borne by the trainees	50%
