

Similarly, the officials working in the pay scales of Rs.1200-2040 and Rs.1400-2300 belonging to the grades other than the Delhi Administration Subordinate Service and Stenographers who have appeared in Part-I or Part-II of the S.S./J.A.O. (Common) Examination held upto the year 1990 and could not qualify the said examination shall be eligible to avail themselves of the chances for appearing in the S.S./J.A.O. (Common) Examination as per Rules of the Scheme for training for S.S. Examination."
