Heard the Petitioner/Complainant who appears in person. It has been explained to the Complainant that the petition as filed, does not disclose a cause of action in terms of Section 2 (b) of the Delhi Lokayukta & Upalokayukta Act for the jurisdiction of this forum to be invoked. The averments in Para – 12 of certain hints being dropped for graft being paid, are stated. These averments are vague and lacking in material particulars.

The Petitioner/Complainant says he is aggrieved on account of injustice that he has received. However, since it does not prima facie disclose a cause of action under Section 2 (b) of the Act, he is permitted to withdraw the complaint.

The **complaint is dismissed as withdrawn**, with liberty to the Petitioner to avail of legal remedies as admissible.
