**ORDER**

NO.F.3(4)/2002/F&S/P&C :- Whereas the Government of India, Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution vide Notification No S.O 2247 (E), dated the 22nd September, 2008 has amended the Removal of (Licensing requirements, Stock Limits and Movement Restrictions ) on Specified Foodstuffs Order 2002 as amended upto date earlier and in Para 3, after the proviso, inserted the following Explanation, namely;-

**“Explanation: If a wholesaler or retailer or dealer is able to demonstrate that part of his or her stocks are sourced from imports, then these would be excluded for the purpose of calculation of stock limit”**

Now, therefore, Lt. Governor of the National Capital Territory of Delhi, in exercise of powers conferred by section 3 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955(10 of 1955) read with the order issued by the Government of India, Ministry of Agriculture ( Department of Food) Notification No G.S.R. 452(E) dated the 25th October, 1972, further amends the Government of National Capital Territory Delhi, Department of Food & Supplies Order No. F.3(4)/2002/F&S/P&C/2009, dated 12<sup>th</sup> May 2008, relating to the Delhi Foodgrains and Oilseeds Dealers Licensing Order, 1988 and Delhi Edible Oil (Licensing and Control) Order, 1977 and inserts the aforesaid “ Explanation” after the proviso in Para 3 of the aforesaid order dated 22<sup>nd</sup> September, 2008



**ORDER**


No.F.3(4)2009/F&S/P&C Whereas the Lt. Governor of the National Capital Territory of Delhi, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 (10 of 1955) read with the order issued by the Government of India, Department of Food Notification No G.S.R. 800 dated the 9<sup>th</sup> June, 1978 ordered vide No F.3(4)2002/F&S/P&C/141 dated 20-4-2009 that order No F 3(4)/2002/F&S/P&C (2)/19 dated the 20-6-2002 relating to Delhi Sugar Dealers Licensing order 1963 shall be kept in abeyance to the extent of the provisions of the Removal of (Licensing Requirements Stock Limits and Movement Restrictions) on Specified Foodstuffs (Amendment) Order 2009 for a period of four months from the date of issue of the said order or further order of Central Government whichever is earlier.

And whereas, the Central Government vide Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution (Department of Consumer Affairs) vide Notification S.O 1621 (E) dated 2<sup>nd</sup> July, 2009 has issued the Removal of (Licensing requirements, Stock limits and Movement Restrictions) on Specified Foodstuffs (Fifth Amendment) Order 2009 and its clauses 2,3, and 4 provide as under:-

- 2 The words and expressions used in respect of purchase, movement, sale, supply, distribution or storage for sale in the Removal of (Licensing requirements, Stock limits and Movement Restrictions) on Specified Foodstuffs Order, 2002 shall be kept in abeyance for commodity, namely, Sugar for a period of six months i.e. upto 8-1-2010 from the date of commencement of this order.
- 3 Nothing contained in this order shall affect the transport, distribution or disposal of sugar to places outside the state, nor shall it be applicable to import of this commodity:  
Provided that the Central Government or State Governments may direct the importers to declare their receipts of stocks of sugar, and stocks retained by them.
- 4 All other provisions of the Removal of (Licensing Requirements, Stock limit and Movement Restrictions) on Specified Foodstuffs Order, 2002 shall continue to remain in force even during the period mentioned in clause 2 above."

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 (10 of 1955) read with the order issued by the Government of India, Department of Food, Notification No G.S.R. 800 dated the 9<sup>th</sup> June, 1978 the Lt. Governor of the National Capital Territory of Delhi hereby orders that order No F.3(4)/2002/F&S/P&C(2)/19 dated the 20<sup>th</sup> June 2002, relating to Delhi Sugar Dealers Licensing Order 1963 shall be kept in abeyance to the extent of the provisions of the Removal of (Licensing Requirements, Stock limits and Movement Restrictions) on Specified Foodstuffs (Fifth Amendment) Order, 2009 for a further period upto 08-1-2010.

स०फा०: 3(4)/2009/एफएण्डएस/पीवसी- जबकि राष्ट्रीय राजधानी क्षेत्र दिल्ली के उपराज्यपाल खाद्य विभाग, भारत सरकार की अधिसूचना संख्या जीएसआर-800 दिनांक 9 जून 1978 द्वारा जारी आदेश के साथ पठित आवश्यक वस्तु अधिनियम 1955 (1955 का 10)की धारा 3 द्वारा प्रदत्त शक्तियों का प्रयोग करते हुए आदेश संख्या फा 3(4)/2002/एफएवएस/पीएंडसी/141 दिनांक 20/4/09 से आदेशित किया था कि दिल्ली चीनी व्यापारी लाइसेंस आदेश 1963 संबंधी आदेश संख्या फा 3(4)/2002/एफएवएस/पीएंडसी(2)/19 दिनांक 20/6/2002 को विनिर्दिष्ट खाद्य पदार्थों संबंधी (लाइसेंसिंग आवश्यकता, स्टॉक, सीमा तथा ढुलाई पर प्रतिबंध) निवारण (संशोधन) आदेश, 2009 को उक्त आदेश के जारी होने की तिथि से चार माह की अवधि या केन्द्रीय सरकार के अगले आदेशों तक, जो पहले हो, स्थगित रखा जाए।

जबकि केन्द्र सरकार ने उपभोक्ता कार्यकलाप खाद्य एवं सार्वजनिक वितरण मंत्रालय, उपभोक्ता कार्यकलाप विभाग के दिनांक 02 जुलाई, 2009 की अधिसूचना स०एस ओ 1621(ई) के द्वारा विनिर्दिष्ट खाद्य पदार्थों संबंधी ( लाइसेंसिंग आवश्यकता, स्टॉक सीमा तथा ढुलाई पर प्रतिबंध ) निवारण (संशोधन) आदेश, 2009 जारी किया गया है। और इस आदेश के खंड 2, 3 और 4 निम्न प्रकार प्रावधान हैं-

2. विनिर्दिष्ट खाद्य पदार्थ संबंधी ( लाइसेंसिंग आवश्यकता, स्टॉक सीमा तथा लाने ले जाने में प्रतिबंध ) निवारण आदेश, 2002 में बिक्री के लिए कय, लाने ले जाने बिक्री, पूर्ति, वितरण या भंडारण संबंधी प्रयुक्त शब्द तथा अभिव्यक्तियां इस आदेश के लागू होने तक आवश्यक वस्तु अर्थात् चीनी के लिए छह माह की अवधि अर्थात् 8/1/2010 तक स्थगित रखे जाएंगे।

3. इस आदेश का कुछ भी राज्य से बाहर के स्थानों में चीनी की ढुलाई, वितरण या निपटान पर प्रभाव नहीं डालेगा या न ही इन वस्तु के आयात पर लागू होगा। शर्त यह है कि केन्द्रीय सरकार या राज्य सरकारें चीनी के स्टॉक की प्राप्तियां तथा उनके द्वारा रखे गए स्टॉक की घोषणा करने के लिए आयातकर्ताओं को निर्देश दे सकती है।

4. विनिर्दिष्ट खाद्य पदार्थ ( लाइसेंसिंग आवश्यकता, स्टॉक सीमा तथा लाने ले जाने में प्रतिबंध ) के निवारण संबंधी आदेश, 2002 के सभी अन्य उपबंध खंड 2 में उल्लिखित अवधि के दौरान प्रवृत्त रहेंगे।

अब इसलिए राष्ट्रीय राजधानी क्षेत्र दिल्ली के उपराज्यपाल कृषि मंत्रालय (खाद्य विभाग), भारत सरकार द्वारा दिनांक 9 जून, 1978 की अधिसूचना संख्या जीएसआर 800 द्वारा जारी आदेश के साथ पठित अनिवार्य वस्तु अधिनियम 1955 (1955 का 10)की धारा 3 द्वारा प्रदत्त शक्तियों का प्रयोग करते हुए राष्ट्रीय राजधानी क्षेत्र दिल्ली के उपराज्यपाल आदेश देते हैं कि दिल्ली चीनी व्यापारी लाइसेंस आदेश, 1963 संबंधी आदेश संख्या फा 03(4)/2002/एफएवएस/पी०एंडसी (2)/19 दिनांक 20/6/2002 को विनिर्दिष्ट खाद्य पदार्थ संबंधी (पॉचवां संशोधन) ( लाइसेंसिंग अपेक्षाएं, स्टॉक सीमा तथा लाने ले जाने में प्रतिबंध ) निवारण आदेश, 2009 के प्रावधानों के अनुसार 08-01-2010 तक की आगामी अवधि के लिए स्थगित रखा जाएगा।

**ORDER**

No.F.3(4)/2002/F&S/P&C. Whereas the Lt. Governor of the National Capital Territory of Delhi rescinded the Delhi Wheat ( Licensing and Control) Order,1996 vide order no F.3(4)/2002-F&S/P&C(1)/21 dated 20<sup>th</sup> June 2002.

Whereas, the Lt. Governor of National Capital Territory of Delhi, in exercise of powers conferred by section 3 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955(10 of 1955) read with the order issued by the Government of India, Ministry of Agriculture (Department of Food) Notification No G.S.R. 452 (E) dated the 25th October, 1972, ordered vide Order No F. 3(4)/2002/F&S/P&C/2602 dated the 7<sup>th</sup> November, 2008 that Order No. F. 3(4)/2002/F&S/Policy(1)/206 dated the 12<sup>th</sup> July, 2004 relating to the Delhi Wheat (Licensing and Control) Order, 1996 and the Delhi Pulses (Licensing of Dealer) Order, 1974 respectively, shall be kept in abeyance, to the extent of the provision of the Removal of (Licensing requirements, Stock limits and Movement Restrictions) on Specified Foodstuffs (Third Amendment) Order, 2008; for a further period upto 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2009 from the date of issue of the said order or further order, whichever is earlier;

whereas, the Central Government vide Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution, Department of Consumer Affairs Notification No. S.O. 880(E) dated 30, March, 2009 has issued the Removal of (Licensing requirements, Stock limits and Movement Restrictions) on specified foodstuffs (Second Amendment) Order, 2009.

And whereas clause 2 of the aforesaid Order provides:-

2. In the Order number S.O. 2117 (E), dated the 27<sup>th</sup> August, 2008,
- (i) in para 2, the words "wheat and " shall be omitted;
  - (ii) in para 3, the words "wheat and " shall be omitted,

with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2009, except as respect things done or omitted to be done before such omission.

Now, therefore, the Lt. Governor of National Capital Territory of Delhi, in exercise of powers conferred by section 3 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955(10 of 1955) read with the order issued by the Government of India, Ministry of Agriculture ( Department of Food) Notification No G.S.R. 800 dated the 9th June, 1978, hereby orders that Order No F.3(4)/2002-F&S/P&C(1)/21 dated 20<sup>th</sup> June 2002, relating to the Delhi Wheat ( Licensing and Control) Order, 1996 shall be further amended to the extent of the provisions of Removal of (Licensing requirements, Stock limits and Movement Restrictions) on specified foodstuffs (Second Amendment) Order, 2009.
