ORDER

The samples of food articles taken under FSS Act, 2006 consist of four * parts and out of these four parts, one counterpart is sent for analysis to the Two counterparts of the samples are deposited with the Food Analyst. concerned Designated Officer and the fourth counterpart of the sample if not sent to the NABL accredited Lab by the FBO, the same is also deposited with the concerned Designated Officer.

Such samples which are not found violating the provisions of FSS Act/Rules & Regulations by the Food Analyst and Director Referral Food Laboratory and need no further action under the said provisions and needs to be disposed of, the Designated Officer and the Food Analyst will prepare a list of cases where disposal of glass bottles and disposal of redundant material of the sample along with their quantity in each bottle and provide the same to the Care Taking branch.

The Care Taking Branch will invite tender for quoting rates for disposal of glass bottles as well as disposal of redundant sample material separately. The Designated Officers and the Food Analyst will hand over the redundant material to the authorised vendor who will be asked to provide certification for safe deposit of redundant material at land fill site to ensure that the material does not enter the food chain. The certificate shall be kept in office record of the respective Designated Officer/Food analyst and a copy at the Care Taking Branch.

The same procedure will be followed for samples after the cases are disposed of at adjudication/trial court/appellate stages.
