ORDER

19.12.2012:

Present : Sh. M.C. Gupta, Appellant and Sh. Daljeet Singh, Sub Registrar-VII/APIO.

Sh. Sh. M.C. Gupta r/o B-1, Sham Nath Apartments, 12 Sham Nath Marg, Civil Lines, Delhi-54 had filed an RTI application dated 11.10.2012 before PIO/Office of the Sub Registrar-VII, seeking information about certain queries with reference to a Relinquishment Deed dated 10.7.2012 registered vide Regn No. 12826 by the co-owner of the property in the office of Sub Registrar.

Sh. Daljeet Singh, Sub Registrar-VII/APIO.vide letter No. SR-VII/RTI/New Delhi/645-646/ID No:549 dated 22.7.2012 had sent him a reply on all the 05 points stating therein that as per guidelines of CIC, reasons, opinions, advice cannot be provided under the RTI Act, 2005.

Now, Sh. M.C. Gupta has further filed an appeal vide his letter dated 29.11.2012, received in this office on 05.12.2012 before the undersigned/First Appellate Authority stating therein that the PIO has furnished evasive reply and not answered his issues.

In this regard an hearing opportunity was given to appellant to appear on 19.12.2012 at 2:30 p.m. with a copy to Sh. Daljeet Singh, Sub Registrar-VII/APIO..

During the course of hearing, it was observed that APIO had sent him a reply vide his letter No. SR-VII/RTI/New Delhi/645-646/ID No:549 dated 22.7.2012 but the appellant was not satisfied with this reply as he is seeking specific directions to be given to Sub Registrar that he has wrongly done in the matter of a Relinquishment Deed dated 10.7.2012 and further sought legal opinion on its related issues.

The appellant further contended before the undersigned that he has some grievances related to evasion of duty and registration of Relinquish Deed dated 10.7.2012 for which he has been advised to approach the right forum for redressal of his grievances on his personal issues.

As no further information can be provided to the appellant as per the provisions of RTI Act, 2005 the information provided by APIO is fully justified .

Appeal is disposed off accordingly.
