ORDER


Distillery/Brewery/Winery are allowed to generate barcode sequence number for printing and pasting of generated barcode numbers on each bottles and cases as per downloaded mapped data.

Once these generated barcode sequence number is dispatched against import permit for Delhi, the same generated barcode sequence number cannot be supplied in Delhi again. Therefore duplicate printing of generated barcode sequence numbers are not allowed at distillery/brewery/winery.

Ensure that printing application at Distillery/Brewery/Winery must not allow reprinting or duplicate printing of barcode sequence numbers if there are printing issues on barcode labels and these barcode sequence numbers cannot be reused for reprinting or duplicating the barcode.

There are instances of duplicate barcode sequence numbers supplied at vends by the distillery/brewery/winery. Therefore, all Distilleries/Breweries/Wineries are directed to comply for generating, printing and pasting as per downloaded mapped data failing which strict penal action as per Delhi Excise Rules, 2010 shall be taken which may include penalty, stopping of IPs and even suspension/cancellation of the License.

All Distilleries/Breweries/Wineries are directed to submit the declaration statement as stated below.
