Sh. Anshul Mittal, Ld. Counsel for the Complainant argued the matter for some time on the issue of misuse and abuse of power by the Respondent public functionary. He persuasively attempted to urge that apart from the non deposit of Rs. 16 crores despite the order passed by the Central Registrar of Cooperative Societies, there were instances of misuse of power. It was pointed out to Ld. Counsel that determination with regard to the directions for deposit of Rs. 16 crores would itself entail a finding that the Respondent public functionary had misused and abused the powers.


After some arguments, Ld. Counsel for the Complainant seeks leave to withdraw the complaint with liberty to approach the appropriate forum for directions to have the decision of Central Registrar Cooperative Societies expedited or decided within a time frame.

The Complainant is granted liberty to withdraw the complaint and approach the appropriate forum as entitled at law.

Needless to mention that in case any cause of action subsists under the Act as a result of the findings of Central Registrar

Cooperative Societies or on account of some other proceedings, then  
it will be open to the Complainant to approach this forum.

Complaint is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
