Sir/Madam,

I am directed to forward herewith two letters received from Special Secretary (Vig.), Directorate of Vigilance, GNCT of Delhi vide letter No.F.1(33/2014/DOV/5492-5497 dated 30-6-2014 regarding Minutes of meeting held in the conference hall in the Chief Secretary's Office on 20-6-2014 at 3:00pm & No.F.98/10/10/DOV/5336 dated 25-6-2014 regarding Strengthening of Vigilance Set-up.

In the meeting held on 26-6-2014, the Chief Secretary expressed his displeasure over the pendency of 69 CVC references in the Revenue Department, and desired that the requisite report/document/information be submitted by the respective District on the prescribed CVC format, along with duly signed Assurance Memo within 4 weeks. He also directed that a meeting of the Deputy Commissioners of the concerned Districts be held by Secretary (Vig.).

Further, DOV has observed that the requisite information/report/documents/record etc. relating to Vigilance matter are not furnished by the concerned Departments in time resulting in avoidable delay in the processing of the cases in the Directorate of Vigilance, particularly in the matter of CVC references. Furthermore, it has also been observed by the DOV that the Vigilance matters are dealt very casually by the Departments and incomplete information/documents are provided resulting in delay in the processing of the cases. The Central Vigilance Commission has taken a serious view in the matter & DOV has emphasized that the Vigilance set-up in the Department/organisation be strengthened.

It is therefore, requested to kindly strengthen the Vigilance set-up in your District, and ensure submission of complete information/report/document/record, on the prescribed CVC format alongwith duly signed assurance memo, in a time bound manner, as and when required by DOV/CVC to enable this office to process the same for onward transmission to DOV/CVC.



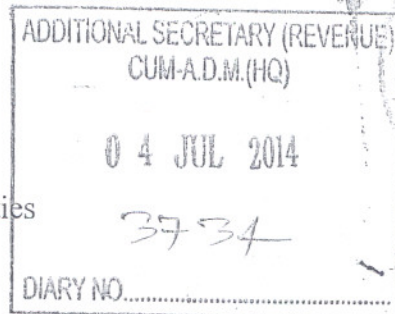

Minutes of the meeting held in the Conference Hall in the Chief Secretary's Office on 20.06.2014 at 3:00 PM

A meeting was held on 20/06/2014 under the chairmanship of Chief Secretary, Delhi, to review the pending CVC references of following departments -

1. Divisional Commissioner
2. H&FW Department
3. Education Department
4. Delhi Police
5. Transport Department
6. TTE Department
7. Registrar, Cooperative Societies
8. North DMC
9. South DMC
10. T&T Department



2. A list of officers who attended the meeting is enclosed as Annexure-A.

3. At the outset, the Pr. Secretary (Vig.) briefed the Chief Secretary about the pendency of a large number of CVC references in the above departments. It was stated that a total of 317 CVC references are pending for reply in respect of 39 different departments. The major departments are - Revenue (69 cases), Health & Family Welfare (51 cases), Education (27 cases), Delhi Police (22 cases), Transport (18 cases), Registrar, Cooperative Societies (19 cases), TTE (17 cases), ACB (10 cases) & Trade & Tax (7 cases). The Chief Secretary expressed concern about the huge pendency of CVC references in the above departments, and desired that all the departments should take prompt and time bound action in the CVC matters, and furnish the requisite report/information/documents to DOV within time limit. Since most of the departments were not having the complete list of pending references, the same was provided to them in the meeting for reconciling the same with their own record. The departments assured the Chief Secretary to submit the requisite report/information/documents **on the prescribed format of CVC, alongwith duly signed assurance memo**, to DOV in time bound manner. In this regard, while Education Department and Transport Department assured to submit the same within 04 weeks, the remaining 08 Departments assured to submit the requisite reports within six weeks.

4. The Chief Secretary expressed his displeasure over the pendency of 69 CVC references in the Revenue Department, and desired that the requisite report/documents/information be submitted by the department on the prescribed CVC format, alongwith duly signed assurance memo, within 04 weeks, and in case, the same is not received by then, a meeting of the Deputy Commissioners of the concerned districts be held by Secretary (Vig.).


