Reference your PGMS complaint dated 09-06-2014 vides which three conditions have been cited which should be removed.

In this regard it is to inform you that:-

- 1) The condition of applicant OBC being a resident of Delhi since 1993 is a requirement which has been decided by the Govt. of India vide O.M. No.36012/22/93-Estt.(SCT) dated 8th September,1993. Hence the Revenue Department has no jurisdiction over the issue and it cannot be removed.
- 2) The applicant is required to submit proof of Date of Birth. It can be Birth certificate or other documents such as certificate of 10th class or 12th class as the case may be in which the Date of Birth of the applicant is mentioned.
- 3) Even if OBC certificate to a family member of the applicant has not been issued earlier, the applicant is eligible to obtain the OBC certificate. However, in such cases the certificate is issued after due verification/field enquiry by the concerned district.
