CIRCULAR

It has been observed that D.C/ Registrar offices are referring the refund cases of registration Fee, seeking clarification regarding admissibility of Registration fee.

All the D.M's/ Registrar's are requested to refer the para's no. 46 and 70 of the instructions of Registration Manuals issued dated 13/08/1996 under No.F.1(13)/Regn./75-76, which is reproduced as under:-

46- Refund of Registration Fees on refusal to register. "In cases in which registration is refused, the Registration Fees received shall be refunded."


70-Refund of registration and copying fees: "The Delhi Administration has delegated to the Registrar power to sanction refund of registration and copying fees on account of excess collections and refunds rendered necessary by an order, which Registrar is himself competent to pass. Such refunds do not require the counter signature of the Inspector General of Registration."

From the above provisions/ Rules, it is clear that Govt. has delegated the power of refund of registration fees to the Registrar. Thus there is no need to refer such cases to this office for seeking clarification/ approval of the IGR/ Finance Deptt., as the Registrar/ D.M is the competent authority for allowance of refund.

All District Magistrate's/ Registrar are accordingly requested to instruct the all concerned to process the cases of refund of registration fees in accordance with the said rules and disposed of all pending cases in a time bond manner.


The Pr. Secy. Revenue/ IGR, Delhi has approved the said instructions in one such case.
