

3. Relevant facts emerging during the hearing

On the last date of hearing, the complainant was not present and a last opportunity was given to him to furnish the video recording or any other evidence in his possession and join the enquiry. The complainant has failed to furnish any evidence nor joined the enquiry.

As per the ATR filed by police, the allegations of breaking open the lock of the basement and stealing of valuables, documents and Rs.2.00 Lac is not found substantiated. The allegations of the complainant that the Sale



Deed shown by the alleged party was forged also could not be substantiated during the course of enquiry as the papers had already been verified from SR Office and found to be genuine.

In today's hearing another ATR has been filed by PG Cell in which a report obtained from Sub Registrar-V has also been enclosed. As per the opinion of the Sub Registrar it has been stated that:-

" As per provision laid down in Section 23 of the Registration Act, 1908, no document other than a WILL shall be accepted for registration unless presented for that purpose to the officer within four months from the date of its execution"
