Whereas in exercise of the powers conferred under section 19 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, the whole of Union Territory of Delhi has been declared as air pollution control area, vide notification no. G.S.R 106 (E) dated 20th February, 1987.

And whereas under section 17 (1) (a) of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, State Pollution Control Board is required, inter alia, to plan a comprehensive programme for the prevention, control or abatement of air pollution and to secure the execution thereof;

And whereas Pollution Under Control (PUC) Certificate is a key regulatory mechanism for enforcing standards in respect of automobile emissions, leading to control of air pollution. National Green Tribunal (NGT) has already passed various directions in O.A. No.21 of 2014 titled "Vardhaman Kaushik Vs. Union of India & others" for checking their pollution.

And whereas, not only PUC centres need to function properly, but also, it is essential to provide adequate number of PUC centres all over the city so that public can easily get their vehicles checked and take follow up action as required under the law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 31 A, sub-section (1) of section 17 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, read with Central Pollution Control Board notification No. S.O 198 (E) dated the 15th March, 1991, the directions are hereby issued to :-

- a) All the owners of petrol pumps in NCT of Delhi through their respective Oil Companies / Petroleum Corporations to set up Pollution Under Control (PUC) Centres for Petrol / CNG & Diesel vehicles at their petrol pumps.
- b) Chairman / Vice Chairman / Commissioner / CEO of all the Municipal bodies / Govt Agencies owning or managing the parking lots to set up PUC Centres for Petrol / CNG & Diesel vehicles in all covered / enclosed (including multi-level) car parking lots having a parking capacity of 100 Equivalent Car Space (ECS) vehicles or more.
- c) Managing Director, Delhi Transport Corporation (DTC) to set up PUC Centres for Petrol / CNG & Diesel vehicles at their DTC Bus Depots.
- d) Executive Director & Joint CEO, Delhi Integrated Multi-Modal Transit System Ltd. (DIMTS) to set up PUC Centres for Petrol / CNG & Diesel vehicles at their Cluster Bus Depots.
- e) Managing Director, Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) to set up PUC Centres for Petrol / CNG & Diesel vehicles at their DMRC Bus Depots and parking lots in NCT of Delhi.

These PUC Centres should be set up by 31.12.2015 as per the standards / procedure prescribed by and in coordination with Transport Department, Govt of NCT of Delhi (GNCTD). The Transport Department is to take up the matter with the concerned Govt agencies / DTC / DIMTS / DMRC / Municipal bodies owning or managing Bus Depots / parking lots and the petrol pump owners, their associations, and if required, also with Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas, Govt of India in order to ensure the implementation of these directions.
