ORDER

Whereas, vide order No. 662 dated 30.7.2015 all L-17/L-18/L-19 Licencees were directed to deposit the enhanced amount of licence fee followed by Order dated 28.8.2015 directing to pay the additional licence fee alongwith interest within 7 days of issue of this order. Further vide order No. 720 dated 17.9.2015 all L-17/L-18/L-19 Licencees were given last opportunity to pay the amount on account of increase in licence fee immediately and were informed that in the event of failing to do so, the TP of the unit will be stopped and Bar be sealed without any further notice.

Where, the L -17/L-18/L-19 licencees as per list enclosed have not deposited the licence fee till date and have thus violated the terms and conditions of the licence as also the provisions of the Delhi Excise Act, 2009 and rules framed thereunder.

Keeping in view of above, I, Praveen Mishra, Deputy Commissioner (Excise)/ Licensing Authority taking cognizance of the default in payment of the additional licence fee, hereby stop the TP and seal the bar of the licencees, as per list enclosed, with immediate effect.

However, in case licencee has already deposited the difference of licence fee or paid the 2<sup>nd</sup> installment they may provide a copy of the same to the inspecting team and action against such licencees may not be taken..
