ORDER

1. Whereas an application was filed on 01/04/2014 by one Sh. Raj Kumar Malhotra for renewal of license of motor driving training school under the name of M/s. New Malhotra Motor Driving Training School. The application under reference was under examination as per existing guidelines and provisions of the Motor Vehicle Act and Rules made there under.
2. Whereas the applicant during the pending process, approached the Hon'ble High Court vide WP(C) 7164/2015 for early disposal of above mentioned application dated 01/04/2014.
3. Whereas the Hon'ble Court disposed of the above referred petition with the direction to the Transport Department to take a decision on the petitioner application dated 01/04/2014 within a period of four weeks.
4. Whereas, every driving school has to get a license from the concerned licensing authority and a duty is cast upon them to produce "quality drivers" for which a quality training is absolutely necessary. The quality of drivers is also crucial to prevention of accidents. The driving schools, therefore, play a key role in producing skillful drivers who could meet the international standards.
5. Whereas several applications for grant/renew of licenses of MDTS were pending with the department for disposal.
6. Whereas, it had been observed that the quality and capability of many of these driving schools / drivers produced are not upto the mark; many existing driving schools are either grossly ill equipped or lack in adequate infrastructure, trained manpower etc., that are required to undertake the job.
7. Whereas, it was imperative on the part of the department to critically review the existing arrangements and bring in place, the required modifications in the stipulations and guidelines so as to have an effective regulation of the driving schools with the sole objective of producing quality and skillful drivers considering transport, traffic, vehicular strength, rights of various road users and all the aspects connected with road safety. Accordingly, keeping in view of public safety, road discipline, better service to public and effective monitoring of the activities of the MDTS through the use of technology, it was decided by the competent authority to constitute a committee to reframe the guidelines / policy for grant of new / renewal of licenses for a MDTS.

8. Whereas, the committee under reference was constituted vide order No.F. DC/Ops/TPT/360/2014/548-52 dated 05/06/2015, which after serial meetings, deliberations and consulting the latest guidelines available on MDTS, submitted the revised guidelines to the competent authority.

9. Whereas, the revised guidelines were examined and considered appropriate for ensuring quality training to driving license seekers, hence the competent authority issued fresh guidelines for granting license to a new/renewal of Motor Driving Training School in NCT of Delhi vide order No.F. DC/OPS/TPT/360/2014/1485-1525 dated 06/08/2015 for compliance with immediate effect.

10. Whereas, now it is imperative for each and every applicants before seeking license for running a new MDTS / before getting the license of MDTS renewed, to fulfill all the criteria / parameters prescribed in the revised guidelines issued on 06/08/2015 so that sole objective of producing quality and skillful drivers considering transport, traffic, vehicular strength, rights of various road users and all the aspects connected with road safety could be achieved.

11. Now, in the light of above observations, the application / representation of Sh. Raj Kumar Malhotra for renewal of MDTS license was examined and found deficient, therefore it is directed to apply a fresh license in their respective zone as per criteria prescribed in new guidelines for issue of new/renewal of MDTS license, if he desires so.

12. This order shall dispose off the application dated 01/04/2014 of Sh. Raj Kumar Malhotra for renewal of license for running a MDTS in the name of M/s. New Malhotra Motor Driving Training School in compliance to the order dated 29/07/2015 of Hon'ble High Court in the matter of WP(C) 7164/2015 titled Raj Kumar Malhotra V/s Govt. of NCT of Delhi and Anr.
