

Report regarding audit of mandatory disclosure of the RTI contents linked with website of NCC Department, Govt. of NCT of Delhi.


As per the request contained in the Office Supdt., NCC Deptt.'s letter no. F.5(4)/AO-NCC/RTI/2012/2379 dated 17.04.2015 on the subject cited above, an audit of the contents of NCC Department's website with reference to mandatory disclosure of information under RTI Act, 2005 was done today and the following observations were noted:

1. The link "RTI" available on NCC Deptt.'s website directs the user to the website "www.delhigovt.nic.in" and after selecting department's option as "NCC" on the page, the 17-Manuals were available for glance. The information open to public was duly provided in these manuals in compliance to Section 4 of the RTI Act, 2005.
2. However, the NCC Department's own website "delhi.gov.in/wps/wcm/connect/DOIT-NCC/ncc/home contains certain other useful links which can prove to be an effective tool for providing proactive information to the public at large. But such links i.e. Circulars, Orders, Important Schemes, Tender Updation, Gazette Notification contained the remarks "No record found".

Suggestions:

In view of the above observations, it is suggested that:

- i) The information on the links "Circulars, Orders, Important Schemes, Tender Updation, Gazette Notification" of NCC Department's home-page should be uploaded as and when needed.
- ii) The website was last updated on "23 March 2014" i.e. almost one year ago. The contents of the website should be updated on frequent intervals for providing proactive information to the public.
