Hearings conducted.


Proceedings were attended by all concerned.

During the hearing petitioner stated that all the above name respondents misbehave with her. She further stated that she is getting rental income of Rupees 28000/- per month and she is not claiming any maintenance from respondents. Respondents stated that her mother since very beginning has ignored them and also misbehave with them.

After taking into account the submissions of all concerned & fact of the case, this Tribunal orders as under :-

1. Since applicant is financial independent, she has not claimed any maintenance and thus no order for maintenance is required to be given.
2. Both the petitioner and respondents are advised to adopt a good behavior towards each other and strive to improve family relations. Respondents are restrained from any physical, verbal or mental abuse to the petitioner, Smt. Ayodhya. SHO, Neb Sarai is directed to provide adequate help whenever approached by the senior citizen, Smt. Ayodhya.


