In Writ Petition (Civil) No. 13029/1985, I.As No. 376-377, 380-381, 382, 390, 445-446, 375, 399-400 dated 12.08.2016 case titled "M.C.MEHTA v/s UNION OF INDIA & ORS." the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has issued directions vide its order dated 12.08.2016 to permit registration of Diesel Cars / SUVs of 2000 cc capacity and above upon deposit with the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) of 1% of the Ex-show room price towards Environment Protection Charge.

- 2. The operative portion of the Hon'ble Supreme Court order dated 12.08.2016 is as under:
  - "... We accordingly direct that the CPCB shall open a separate account in a Scheduled public sector bank to receive the amount representing 1% of the Ex-show room price of every diesel car that is sold by any manufacturer/dealer in Delhi and NCR region. The deposit of the amount alone shall entitle the manufacturer/dealer or the purchaser of the car to have the car registered within Delhi or NCR region. Our order dated 16.12.2015 shall to that extent stand modified. We, however, leave open the question whether cars less than the capacity of 2000 cc using diesel fuel should also be subjected to a similar charge...".
- 3. In compliance of the aforesaid directions, all the Registering Authorities / MLOs are hereby directed to register Diesel Cars / SUVs of 2000 cc capacity and above upon production of the proof of the deposit of 1% of the Ex-show room price towards Environment Protection Charge with Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB).
- 4. This issues with the prior approval of the competent authority.
