Sir,

1. Refer rule 15&16 of GPF (CS) rules 1960 and amendment to the provisions of GPF (CS) rules, 1960 issued vide O.M No. 3/2/2097-98 PW(F) (ii) dt.07/03/2017 duly endorsed by finance depart. GNCT of Delhi.
2. The department follows the GPF (CS) rules 1960 and instruction / guidelines issued from time to time from Govt. of India duly endorsed by Delhi Govt.
3. Refer rule 15 & 16 of GPF (CS) RULES,1960
4. Refer rule 15 & 16 of GPF (CS) RULES,1960
5. As per the GPF (CS) Rule 1960, no time –limit has been prescribed for sanction and payment of withdrawal amount. How ever, the amended rules prescribe a maximum time limit of fifteen days for sanction and payment of withdrawal from the fund. In case emergencies like illness etc. the time limit may be restricted to seven days.
