
An RTI application dated 22.9.2016 has been filed by Shri H.R. Vaish seeking a series of information regarding details of the societies registered under the Societies Registration Act.

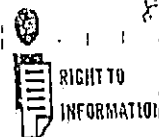

Order on the first appeal dated 10.12.2016 filed under section 19(1) of RTI Act

1. This order will dispose of the first appeal dated 10.12.2016 filed by Shri HR Vaish, received on 13.12.2016 in respect of RTI petition dated 22.09.2016 (I.D. No. 2204).
2. Appellant vide his RTI petition dated 22.09.2016 sought information on various points, which was responded by PIO at CMO vide response dated 19.10.2016. Since information on point-numbers 4(i) to (vii) related to registration of societies, the petition was transferred under section 6(3) of RTI Act to SDM (HQ) at the office of Divisional Commissioner GNCTD for point-numbers 4(i) to (vii) vide letter dated 26.09.2016 from PIO at CMO. Therefore, the appellant should have filed the first appeal under section 19(1) of RTI Act at the office of Divisional Commissioner GNCTD rather than at CMO.
3. This first appeal may be forwarded to the First Appellate Authority at the office of Divisional Commissioner GNCTD for appropriate action at their end as per provisions of RTI Act, 2005.
4. The appeal is disposed of accordingly.

Sub: 1st Appeal under RTI Act, 2005

Madam,

Vide my e-mail dated 8.8.2016, I had addressed the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Delhi on the subject "Making Officers Accountable - Role of Administration, why should an admin have to go to Court against the Government?" A copy of this mail is annexed herewith as Annexure A.

Annexure B is the RTI application filed by me in your office.

The responses received from PIO Alipur, Shahdara, North, Delhi Cantt., South West and your office are as per Annexure C (colly).

The varied and partial responses show that the proper information sought has not been provided. The information sought is very important and is required to see on what basis the decision making is happening in the Government or is it totally arbitrary leading to corrupt practices, so well known to exist in the office of the Registrars.

In fact, the O/o the Registrar (South) did not have the letter issued by them, and attached by them in their response, on their file. A scanned copy of the same was obtained telephonically from the undersigned and the said Registrar has the audacity to enclose the same in response to the RTI filed by the undersigned. This shows how irresponsibly the matters are being handled and the citizens harassed based on trumped up short comings even when adequate documentation to prove them wrong is provided to them. It is this sort of functioning, which has been holding the country back inspite of the best efforts being made by the political leadership of the country and states.

It is very important, therefore, that whatever is claimed by them, as the basis for their decision making, must exist on Government files and available when RTI applications are filed. Public authorities are the repository of information, which the citizens have a right to access under the Right to Information Act, 2005. The Act casts important obligations on public authorities so as to facilitate the citizens of the country to access the information held under their control. As mandated by the Government, proper management of records is of utmost importance for effective implementation of the provisions of the Act and a public authority should maintain all its records properly. It should ensure that the records are duly catalogued and indexed in such a manner and form that it may facilitate the right to information.

It is a matter of regret that the Registrar (South) did not have the letter issued by them, and attached by them in their response, on their file. A scanned copy of the same was obtained telephonically from the undersigned and the said Registrar has the audacity to enclose the same in response to the RTI filed by the undersigned. This shows how irresponsibly the matters are being handled and the citizens harassed based on trumped up short comings even when adequate documentation to prove them wrong is provided to them. It is this sort of functioning, which has been holding the country back inspite of the best efforts being made by the political leadership of the country and states.

information. From the responses, even after 11 years of the Act of 2005, the records are not available, that too under a Chief Minister who has been in the forefront of the RTI movement. Moreover, every public authority is required to provide as much information suo motu to the public through various means of communications so that the public have minimum need to use the Act to obtain information. Section 4(1)(b) of the Act, in particular, requires every public authority to publish sixteen categories of information, including the procedure followed in the decision making process, with channels of supervision and accountability, the norms set by it for the discharge of its functions, the rules, regulations, instructions, manuals and records, held by it or under its control or used by its employees for discharging its functions.

Amongst other requirements, the Government has stressed:

- a. That publication of the information as referred to above is not optional; it is a statutory requirement which every public authority is bound to meet.
- b. The disclosures should be kept up to date and the disclosure of information may be made keeping in mind the provisions of Section 8 to 11 of the RTI Act.
- c. Every public authority should keep in view that Proactive disclosures on its website are complete, easily accessible, technology and platform neutral and in a form which conveys the desired information in an effective and user-friendly manner.

It is therefore requested that the information sought, as required to be furnished by the RTI Act, be provided to establish that the decisions being taken by the concerned public functionaries are not arbitrary but based on proper rules and regulations.
