ORDER


The Digital India Land Records Modernization Programme (DILRMP) launched by Government of India, aims to modernise management of land records, minimize scope of land/property disputes and enhance transparency in the land records. Revenue Department, Govt. of NCT of Delhi is implementing this project to develop a modern, comprehensive and transparent land records management system.

In this regard, the Service for the Issuance of digitally signed ROR (Right of Record) is offered to citizens at IndraprasthaBhu-Lekh (Delhi Land Record Information), Revenue Department, Government of NCT of Delhi (<http://dlrc.delhigovt.nic.in/>). Land Records of all rural villages of Delhi except for the villages of District North and the villages which are under Consolidation/enquiry/PLR Act/Mutilated records have been digitized and digitally signed. Only digitally signed ROR are being issued at the district offices w.e.f 1st Nov 2016 for the khatas which are digitally signed.

As a next step towards implementation of DILRMP, a web based Mutation Module has been developed by NIC which is available at e-district . **No manual mutation will be carried out by District offices with immediate effect.** The mutation through this software will be automatically linked with the online ROR which is functional since 1st November 2016. The application for mutation can be submitted at the Citizen Service Centers of the respective district offices.

All the District Magistrates ^{may please} shall ensure the compliance of this order with immediate effect.
