



I am directed to say that the three Scholarship Schemes viz. Pre-Matric, Post-Matric and Merit-cum-Means based Scholarship Schemes is being implemented by the Government of India, with 100% Central funding. Under these schemes, the scholarships are awarded to the meritorious students from notified minority Jains, pursuing studies in India in a Government or Private Universities/Institutes/colleges/schools.
