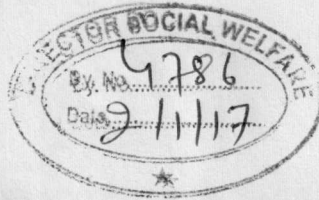
Madam/Sir,

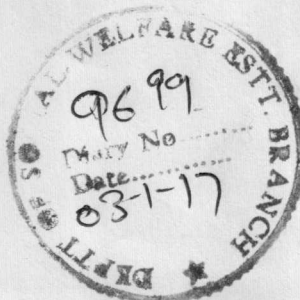
