ORDER

In Writ Petition (Civil) No. 13029/1985, I.As Nos. 494/2017, 489/2017, I.A. No.495/2017 dated 29.03.2017 case titled "M.C.MEHTA v/s UNION OF INDIA & ORS." the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has issued following directions vide its order dated 29.03.2017:-

"(a) On and from 1st April, 2017 such vehicles that are not BS-IV compliant shall not be sold in India by any manufacturer or dealer, that is to say that such vehicles whether two wheeler, three wheeler, four wheeler or commercial vehicles will not be sold in India by any manufacturer or dealer on and from 1st April, 2017.

(b) All the vehicle registering authorities under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 are prohibited for registering such vehicles on and from 1st April, 2017 that do not meet BS-IV emission standards, except on proof that such a vehicle has already been sold on or before 31st March, 2017"

In compliance of the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court, all Registering Authorities / MLOs shall not register any motor vehicle which does not meet the BS-IV emission standards w.e.f. 01.04.2017.

In case, a vehicle is claimed to have been sold before 01.04.2017, the Registering Authorities / MLOs shall obtain proof of that sale and will personally satisfy themselves about the correctness of that proof.



Since, the Hon'ble Supreme Court has prohibited the sale of any vehicle, which is not BS-IV compliant, all the motor vehicle dealers are directed through concerned MLOs, to strictly comply with the aforesaid order of Hon'ble Supreme Court.

All Registering Authorities / MLOs should also obtain the details of number of BS-III vehicles sold but not registered till 31.03.2017 from all the dealers in their jurisdiction. The details shall include, Chassis & Engine Number, Type & model of vehicle and Name, Address details of PAN Card and Aadhar Card of the Purchaser and Invoice No., date and details of payment upto 08.00 PM on 31.03.2017 through mail / hard copies.

In case of sale of any BS-III vehicle on or after 01.04.2017, necessary legal action including cancellation of Trade Certificate shall be taken against the dealer and the concerned dealer shall also be held liable of contempt of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

This issues with the prior approval of Commissioner (Transport).


